#### LOCATION

Phinda Mountain Lodge lies within the 23 000 hectare (56 800 acre) &Beyond Phinda Private Game Reserve, in the Maputaland region of KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa. Phinda neighbours the iSimangaliso Wetland Park (formerly the Greater St Lucia Wetland Park) - a World Heritage Site to the east and is only 30 km (19 miles) due west of the white-fringed beaches of the Indian Ocean.

#### ACCESS

By road: 6 hours from Johannesburg, 3 hours from Durban, 1½ hours from Richards Bay. By air: Federal Air operates a direct return flight daily from Johannesburg International Airport to Phinda. SA Express offer daily scheduled flights from Johannesburg to Richards Bay. Road transfers from Durban International Airport to Phinda can be arranged. Phinda Airwing can also arrange private charters from anywhere in South Africa directly to Phinda's airstrip.

## ACCESS

By road: 6 hours from Johannesburg, 3 hours from Durban, 1½ hours from Richards Bay. By air: SA Express offer daily scheduled flights from Johannesburg to Richards Bay. Road transfers from King Shaka International Airport to Phinda can be arranged. Phinda Airwing can also arrange private charters from anywhere in South Africa directly to Phinda's airstrip.

## GUEST ACCOMMODATION

The lodge features 25 air conditioned suites each with ensuite bathroom comprising bath, shower, separate w.c. and twin hand basins. All suites have a sitting area, personal bar and private veranda complete with plunge pool and romantic al fresco shower. The 25 suites will include 3 suites with a fold-out sleeper sofa in each to accommodate a triple. A family suite with four bedrooms and a shared sitting area.

## GUEST SAFETY

The lodge is not fenced off, and we request guests to be extremely vigilant at all times. Under no circumstances is a guest to walk around the lodge/camp at night, unless accompanied by a security guard.

## GUEST AREAS

A spacious u-shaped building, with central al fresco courtyard, incorporates ample sitting and dining areas. These areas lead out onto a shaded terrace and three-tiered spacious veranda with spectacular views of the Lebombo Mountains and bushveld. Additional facilities include a Safari Shop, interpretive centre, dramatic open-air boma, shaded swimming pool and observation deck. Meeting room available for a maximum of 30 people. For conferencing or meetings of more than 30 people, Phinda management will set up an air conditioned marquee, at an additional cost.

## SAFARIS

Twice-daily game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles, nature walks and excellent birding on Phinda Private Game Reserve. Riverboat cruises and canoeing along the Mzinene River. Optional Phinda Adventures, which are available at an additional cost, include breathtaking coastal flights, beach excursions including snorkelling and scuba diving, deep-sea fishing, turtle viewing (season Nov/Dec/Jan), horse riding and cultural visits.

<b>Weather:</b>	Subtropical climate with hot, humid, wet summers (September to April) and warm to cool, dry winters (May to August).
<b>Rainfall:</b>	Rainfall averages about 1 000mm/39" per annum. Much of the rainfall comes in the form of short, intense afternoon thunderstorms. Rain can be expected 12 months of the year.
<b>Temperature:</b>	Daytime temperatures in summer may rise above 35°C/95°F. Nights in winter rarely drop below 10°C/50°F.
<b>Best time to travel:</b>	All year round, best game viewing from March to end September.
<b>Malaria:</b>	Phinda is situated in a low-risk malaria area.
<b>Children:</b>	Children are welcome. Regretfully, children 5 years and younger cannot participate in the regular game drives. Childminders can be booked at an additional cost. Children aged 6 to 11 are accommodated on game drives at the lodge manager's discretion. No more than 3 triples and 1 quad at any one time. This lodge is highly recommended for families.
