## We can organise and provide the following as part of your Maasai Blessing Ceremony at Governors' Camp:

- The venue: A beautiful location for the ceremony, either at camp or on the banks of the Mara River.
- Maasai elders and senior women from the village to grace the occasion.
- A group of young Morans and beautiful Maasai ladies will perform a celebratory dance while you read your vows.
- Maasai ornaments for the bride and groom.
- Maasai shukas for the groom and the ceremony.
- Flowers to decorate the venue and your vehicle. We suggest earthy tones to blend in with your natural surroundings but the choice is yours.
- A three-tiered vanilla cake and a bottle of sparkling wine.
- A group dinner on the day of your ceremony, will be beautifully set up at
- Governors' Camp.

- After the occasion, the bride and groom will receive a Maasai name.
