Lapa Rios is a 1000-acre rainforest reserve in the wild, Osa Península. The Most Biologically Intense Place on Earth. In this incredible environment, guests can look forward to once-in-a-lifetime rainforest adventures, wildlife encounters and ocean activities. While some come with a bold spirit for exploring and others in search of nature's tranquillity, both will find myriad opportunities to connect with this enigmatic ecosystem.

Lapa Rios is part of the collection of Böëna Wilderness Lodges. Böëna a small chain of stunning hotels including Pacuare Lodge, on the banks of the rushing Pacuare River; Tortuga Lodge, amidst the canals of Tortuguero on the northern Caribbean coast; Monteverde Lodge, in the heights of the cloud forests of Monteverde; and Lapa Ríos Lodge, in the wilderness of the Osa Peninsula

Sustainability at Lapa Rios Lodge

Lapa Rios protects over 1000 acres of Central America's last remaining lowland tropical rainforest and runs a Plant-a-Tree reforestation program. 100% of the electricity consumed at the lodge is clean generated by hydroelectric turbines and solar panels. A small on-site pig farm produces biogas for the staff kitchen and the edible garden produces herbs and greens. Lapa Rios also runs an innovative program, training nature guides to maintain ecotourism in the community as the main source of income.

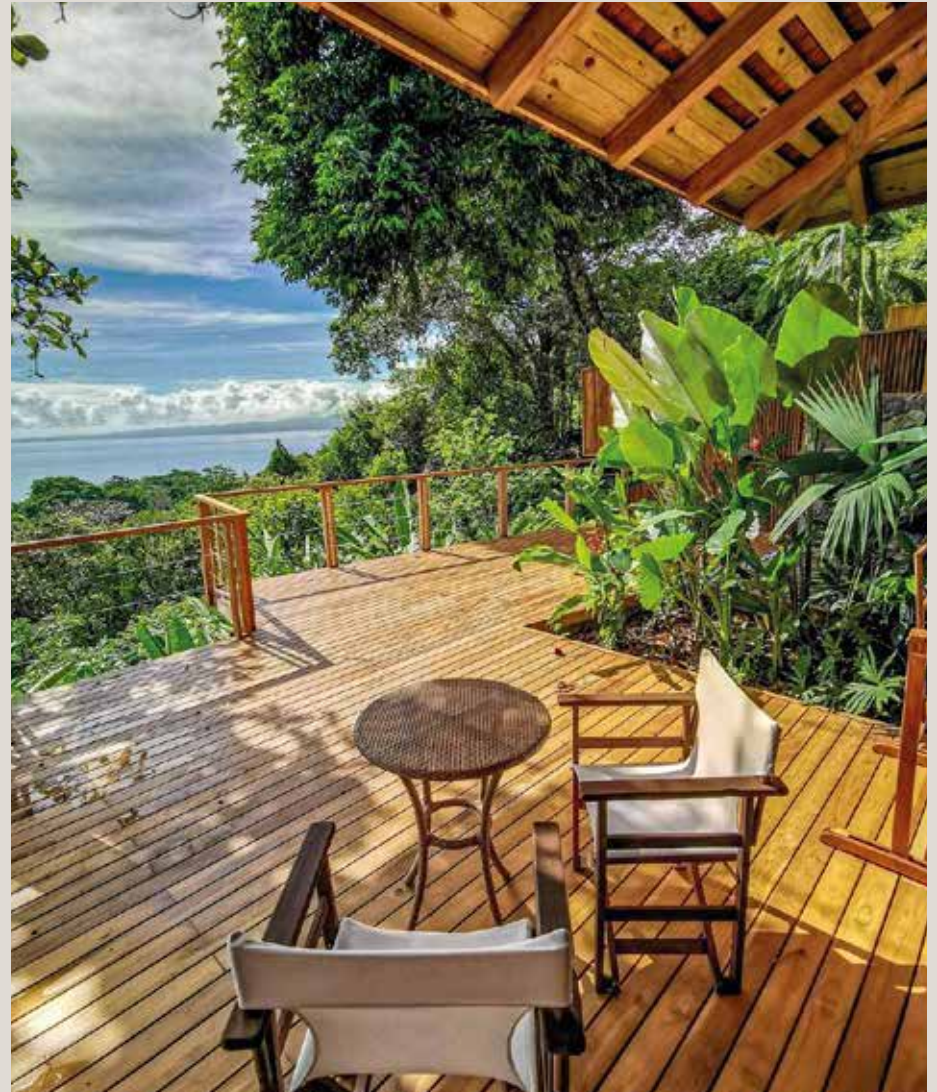
