LOCATION

Kitich Camp is situated in the 800,000 acre Namunyak Wildlife Conservancy On the upper slopes of the Mathews Mountains, which cover approximately 900 km² and the astounding peaks rise 6000 ft. from the surrounding lowlands.

SETTING

Kitich Camp is in a truly remote and pristine wilderness oasis, located in an exquisite forest glade overlooking the Ngeng river.

ACCESS

Scheduled flights to Nanyuki to connect with private charter to Ngelai Airstrip.
Scheduled flights to Samburu Kalama.
Private charter to Ngelai Airstrip (45 mins from camp).

NEED TO KNOW...

- Closed 15th March – June 15th. Nov 1st – Dec 15th
- Camp is run on 24hr solar power.
- Hosted, with 'communal' mess area with fully stocked bar,
- Game can be viewed from the camp deck as they come to drink
- No phone signal at camp. There is WIFI in the office and a satellite phone.
