LOCATION | SETTING

Situated directly under the majestic Mount Kilimanjaro, in the hidden gem of the Enduimet Wildlife Management Area.

Located adjacent to the UNESCO site Mt. Kilimanjaro National Park to the south-east and it's famed crater highlands, there are unlimited ways to enjoy this area along with the magnificent Great Rift Valley. The Kenyan-Tanzania border sits to the north of the Enduimet Wildlife Management Area.

About two hours drive to Arusha National Park, there are over 1,000 square kilometers, that encompass Ngurdoto crater, savannahs, lakes and vast plains filled with wildlife.

A permanent camp, set high on a ridge designed and positioned to capture stunning 360 degree views of the savannah and Kilimanjaro.



ACCESS | ACCOMMODATION

International & scheduled flights - Kilimanjaro International Airport & Arusha Airport.

Arriving from Kilimanjaro Airport, drive via Boma N'gombe, approx. 2 hours.

From Arusha Airport. via Longido, approx. 2 hours drive. From Hatari Lodge, via Ngabobo, approx. 1 1/2 hour drive.

If guests arrive after 6pm, we recommend a night at Hatari first and then onto Shu'mata in the morning. From Shumata to West Kilimanjaro airstrip approx. 45 min drive.

Perfectly positioned to encompass the unique views across the wilderness and Mt. Kilimanjaro.

Each of the seven tents is self contained with a full bath and private veranda.

A traditional safari camp, the interiors and décor have all been designed as a tribute to the bygone era and are chic and colorful.



HIGHLIGHTS | NEED TO KNOW

Shu'mata treads lightly in this fragile ecosystem. Classic and nostalgic safari ambience with amazing rustic elegance.

All solar powered: sockets in lounge only; lights; hot water boilers etc. No generator.

Activities galore!

- Visit the Shira Plateau, a chance to climb the foothills of Mt. Kilimanjaro: 'Kili For All'. Sundown Spear Throw, Maasai Naturalist Walk, Kilimanjaro-Amboseli Eco-systems
- Beehive Fence Project & Maasai cultural experience.

Two hours drive to Arusha National Park. Aiming to be 100% sustainable, all food in locally sourced and organic.

Most team member are Maasai and from their homelands.

We have no soda bottles, no tetrapacks and provide biodegradable toiletries made locally. All meals are served in the baroque styled mess tent on an elegant long dining table or on the outside with panoramic views of Kilimanjaro.



TOP TIPS

To Pack - Suntan lotion, Natural Mosquito repellent, Sun Hat, binoculars, comfortable walking shoes, dress like an onion (especially during the winter months)

Visa - Required for most passports. Visitors to Tanzania are now able to apply electronically.

Malaria Area - No! Mosquitos - Yes

Yellow Fever - Please check with your medical advisor if vaccination required

Gratuity: Lodge/Camp Staff - Gratuities can be paid on departure and are split between all team members.

The expected gratuity amount at the lodge/camp is US\$15.00 per room per day

Rangers, Scouts & Guides - The expected gratuity amount for rangers is US\$15.00

BEEHIVE FENCE PROJECT

At about 15:00, we set off to the Maasai Village of Tinga Tinga, where guests will learn more of this little town and its people. Tinga Tinga's farmlands are often destroyed by elephants crossing over them - a situation causing a serious human-elephant conflict, sometimes even resulting in fatalities on either side.

Lucy King, renowned Kenyan researcher, discovered a brilliant solution: A Beehive Fence, consisting of hanging beehives connected by wire. As elephants instinctively avoid the African Honeybee, farmlands enclosed by such a beehive fence will be spared.

Take the opportunity to add one beehive to the fence with your travel group at an additional cost, thereby contributing towards the safety of villagers and elephants. The brand-new beehive sponsored by your group will carry your signature and leave a lasting legacy. After mounting the hive, you will be invited inside the village to learn more about the Maasai, and your guide, a Maasai himself, will explain more about the decision of one of the world's last nomadic tribes to settle.

After hearing interesting accounts and fascinating stories, you will be taken to a beautiful spot to enjoy the breath-taking sunset, while drinks and snacks will be served. Driving back to Shu'mata in total darkness, surrounded by the African starry sky. Departing with the knowledge that you contributed towards a sustainable solution for Tinga Tinga: saving elephants, creating a new occupation for the local Maasai as beekeepers, who thus have a way of earning income by selling the honey, and building homes for the pollinators we all depend on. Take the opportunity to buy a few jars of honey to take home and give as a personalised gift to your friends and family.

RESERVATIONS PROCEDURES

All applications for provisional or confirmed reservations are to be made by the operator via email addressed to The African Embassy. No reservation will be made deemed unless acknowledged and accepted in writing by The African Embassy.

Provisional reservations will be held for 7 days/until we receive another request for the required rooms. We give the right of first refusal. Group reservations: The African Embassy reserves the right to request a release or confirmation of a provisional booking from the operator should they receive a confirmed booking against the space held by the operator or require a minimum non-refundable deposit, as stipulated on the next page, to be paid by the operator within 7 days to secure the space.

INFORMATION REQUIRED

TRAVEL INSURANCE AND COVID T&C

All travellers are strongly advised to purchase fully comprehensive travel insurance with CFAR (Cancel For Any Reason). This insurance must be able to fully cover the cancellation of travel less than 30 days prior to arrival.

The well-being of our guests, staff and trade partners is of great importance and we take every precaution.

Reservations that need to be postponed or cancelled due to COVID-19 infections, restrictions, or travel regulations can be requested to be postponed up to 7 days before arrival with no penalty provided the applicable documentation is supplied. Cancellations are dealt with case-by-case.
