Chipembele is an innovative, contemporary and international award winning conservation education organisation. We support and serve the children and community who live amongst the rapidly developing rural community close to the main entrance to South Luangwa National Park in Zambia. We run extensive, inspirational and community appropriate programmes, teaching children in 17 local schools to protect, value and conserve the local wildlife and natural environment. This education will help to generate sustainable development for the benefit of the local population for generations to come.

Our programmes encourage and promote personal development, peer support, leadership skills and gender equality amongst the students. We run 22 active school conservation clubs, provide daily student computer lessons and offer sponsorships and scholarships for those wishing to pursue careers related to conservation, eco-tourism, wildlife or natural sciences.
