Project #1

Conservation South Luangwa is a non-profit, community-based organization committed to the conservation and preservation of the local wildlife and natural resources in Luangwa, while at the same time ensuring and encouraging community development amongst local populations.

It was set up in 2003 and relies entirely on donations from members and grant applications. Programs include Wildlife Rescue and Rehabilitation, Conservation Education, Human Wildlife Conflict, and Law Enforcement.

Needs

Camping Supplies:

Project #2

Chipembele Wildlife Education Center is a fun, interactive, and contemporary learning facility for Zambian children which serves 1,000 children each year and 1,000 more children in the valley are served through their outreach programs. It focuses its programs on wildlife, the environment, and conservation issues.

This education will help to both protect the wildlife and generate sustainable development for the benefit of the local population for generations to come, through employment in the tourism and wildlife protection organizations established in the South Luangwa Valley. Other projects include a pupil sponsorship scheme (in which approximately 100 orphaned or vulnerable children are sponsored each year), the improvement of the school infrastructure, local community initiatives, and fully-accredited wildlife rescue, rehabilitation, and release programs.
