



ZARAFSA CAMP

Moments after lifting from camp, you will appreciate an entirely different perspective from the air. The helicopter will enable you to explore areas that are unreachable by any other means, covering large expanses of this incredible, 130,000-hectare reserve.

Your scenic flight will fly over the Zibidianja Lagoon and its resident hippos, located at the source of the iconic Savuti Channel. Red lechwe continually graze the isolated islands in the floodplains. As you sweep southward, elephants can often be spotted enjoying a drink from the channel or a shady respite from the African sun. Your scenic flight continues south over mopane bushland, following the Savuti Channel that attracts herds of thirsty wildlife, including zebras, buffalos, elephants and a myriad of smaller plains antelope, along with their elusive predators.

Our scenic flight will not only showcase incredible sweeping views of the permanent waterways, your pilot will be constantly on the lookout for descendants of Zarafa's namesake, the beloved giraffe once gifted by the Viceroy of Egypt to Charles the 10th of France. The rich history of the area is brought to life through its incredible wildlife and stunning landscapes, fit for any explorer.
