

The renowned Duba Plains Camp sits in the heart of the Okavango Delta.

A matrix of palm-dotted islands, flood plains and woodland, the 33 000-hectare private reserve is typical of the region's unique landscape. Duba Plains Camp offers 5 bespoke suites, in addition to a separate 2-bedroom suite aptly named the Duba Plains Suite, all designed by Dereck Joubert to blend into the forest and to take advantage of the shapes and textures of the shade but also to evoke the old classic African safari style of the 1920's. It is a wildlife connoisseur's getaway with literally thousands of animals in an almost endless pattern across the flood plains. All the suites are raised on recycled railway sleeper decking and offer guests amazing views of the surrounding floodplain and the steady stream of wildlife parading past.

This is the place that the owners, and National Geographic filmmakers, conservationists and explorers, Dereck and Beverly Joubert, chose for their home base. Great Plains Conservation is the only operator on the concession, thereby offering guests the ultimate opportunity for private wildlife sightings.



ACTIVITIES Safari Drives

Early morning, late afternoon/ evening or even full day safari drives take place in some of Botswana's best-adapted vehicles. Duba Plains Camp's Toyota Land Cruisers are uniquely designed to traverse the floodplains. We choose to accommodate four guests (or two couples) on a safari vehicle; however, if a family or group travels together, we would easily accommodate up to six guests. Our vehicles also have fridges stocked with drinks and snacks, ready for longer days out if the wildlife viewing is exciting and just too hard to leave.

Every day is different on safari. Safari Drives often start at sunrise, returning to camp for a late breakfast and departing again mid-afternoon after tea before returning just after sunset. However, guests can often spend the entire day out in the veld with a packed breakfast, lunch, and beverages if they wish. Our safaris will often continue into the night in search of nocturnal species. Night drives are incredibly prolific, and while they take patience, sightings commonly include lesser-known nocturnal mammals and even lion and hyena hunts.

Our schedule is flexible, and guests are encouraged to create their own itinerary according to their interests with guidance and recommendations from our professional guides.

Guided walks

Our guides are keen walking and birding specialists and therefore encourage guests to experience everything we have to offer.



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Photography

- The customised Land Cruisers are open-sided, canopied and customised for photographers (raised roofs, photographic bars, multi-plug inverters);
- Custom built boat offering fixed camera mounts and swivel chairs specifically allowing for enhanced wildlife photographic opportunities from the water channels;
- Because we focus on photographic safaris, each of Duba Plains' guest suites has a professional camera set, including a camera body and lenses. Photos will be downloaded to a USB flash stick on guest's departure. Each suite comes with a pair of high-quality binoculars for guest use as well.

Boating

The flat-bottomed, aluminium boat at Duba Plains allows guests to explore the papyrus flanked channels of the Okavango Delta. Enjoy the amazing birdlife seen, or the occasional elephant or other wildlife seen on the banks. Marvel at the clear, cool water flowing under you and marvel at the journey that this life sustaining liquid undertakes. It has been said that a splash of Okavango Delta water unlocks unknown flavours and aromas from one's favourite whiskey. Boating is subject to water levels.

Fishing

A rod/reel kit is available for those who want to try their cast in the Delta between March and December on a catch and release basis - water level dependent.

Mekoro

Explore the Okavango Delta's permanent channels by mekoro (when water levels allow). This is truly a refreshing yet peaceful experience allowing for wildlife and bird viewing from a unique perspective.

Private vehicle option

Available for more flexibility upon request at extra cost, not compulsory for families travelling with children.

Private Guides

Private guides are encouraged and welcomed.

Scenic Flight and Champagne Stop

Enjoy an aerial viewing experience with great scenery across the northern part of the Okavango Delta. Add a 15-minute champagne stop on palm island en route. Must be booked in advance and is subject to extra cost and availability.

CENTRAL FACILITIES

- Main area includes a media centre, wine cellar, interactive kitchen, dining area, lounge and library;
- Coffee/tea station;
- Large deck leading to a raised deck with additional outdoor dining space and fire pit with seating;
- Great Plains Safari Boutique selling locally and regionally produced crafts, many of which support local community projects in the nearby Okavango panhandle. - Our world-class meals are Relais & Châteaux recognised;
- All meals included and prepared by our Executive Chefs and their teams;

- Oversized double beds with mosquito nets, as well as fly netting on all suite sides;
- Singular environmentally friendly air-conditioner over the guest's bed area;

- The Duba Plains Suite is a 2-bedroom private accommodation unit with private pools separate fact sheet available:
- Suites can be configured as double or single accommodation.

Bathroom features

- En-suite with flush toilet, shower (indoor and outdoor), double basins;
- Luxury baths;

- Soap, shampoo, conditioner, lotion and hairdryers provided.

ACCOMMODATING CHILDREN AND SHARING ACCOMMODATION

- We look forward to having children stay with us that are 6 years and older;
- Triples for children sharing with adults can be arranged upon request;
- The 2 bedroomed Duba Plains Suite is ideal for families staying at Duba Plains;
- Families with children may be accommodated in the same vehicle as other guests unless a private safari vehicle is booked prior to arrival;
- Scheduled wildlife viewing activities, including safari drives, guided walks, and power boating, are available to guests from 6 years when accompanied by their parents or guardians. Where available, canoe and mokoro activities specifically welcome guests aged 8 years and above;







RESERVE CHATEAUX

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- Young children must be supervised as the camp is open with high predator densities in and around camp and there is water surrounding camp. The camp also features raised decks and pools which are not covered;
- Great Plains Young Explorers program thoughtfully designed to explore a range of experiences and topics from birding to cooking to art to tracking wildlife.

SPA TREATMENTS

In-room massages are available at an additional cost.

FITNESS

- Spinning bicycle available on request;
- Yoga mat, light weights available in each suite.

LAUNDRY

POWER AND COMMUNICATION


Power

- The camp is solar powered with generator back-up;
- The system produces 220V, 24-hour electricity to the suites and main area;
- Plug points in each suite;
- Type of plug: South African round and international plug adapters are also available in the suites.

INTERNET & MOBILE

- Wi-Fi in guest suites is available;
- No mobile reception.







HEALTH AND SAFETY Health

- Malaria: Minimal exposure risk– Malaria prophylaxis are recommended if guests are concerned; however, this is a remote area with little occurrence;
- Guests must hold comprehensive medical insurance and emergency evacuation insurance;
- Senior staff all has first aid training;
- Nearest decent medical facility is in Maun, and then Johannesburg.

Possibility of Disabled access

- The camp layout is ideal for guests with walking challenges or who are wheelchair-bound due to the compacted earth pathway between the main area and the suites;
- The suite closest to the main area offers a ramp to access the suite from the pathway. The outside deck, sala, indoor lounge, bedroom and indoor bathroom areas are all on one level. A removable ramp is also available to allow guests access to the sunken pool deck area of the suite;
- Access to the main area is possible via a ramp for guests with walking challenges or who are wheelchair-bound;





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Safety

- This remotely located camp is unfenced to wild animals that do move through the property especially at night;
- Fire extinguishers in every suite.


- Staff gratuities can be paid by credit card or in Botswana Pula, South African Rands, US Dollars (2004 bills or later only) or GB Pounds;

FOUNDATION INITIATIVE Rhinos Without Borders


In 2015, a rhino was poached every 6.3 hours in South Africa. In response to this crisis, Great Plains Conservation rallied various travel industry stakeholders to join forces with us and primary partner, andBeyond, to commit to increasing the Botswana population by 100 rhinos from poaching hot zones in South Africa to safe havens in Botswana. By moving 87 rhinos in and with the 63 additional calves born we exceeded expectations and achieved our goal. Now we must protect them, so we have made a transition from relocating rhinos to monitoring and protecting them in the face of a new wave of poaching continent-wide.
