OI Tukai Lodge is renowned as one of the best spots in the world to watch elephants. It is set at the foot of Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest freestanding mountain in the world and Africa's tallest mountain. It is situated right in the heart of Amboseli National Park, one of East Africa's captivating wildlife parks, with the eastern part of the lodge being home to several elephant families. Writers have described OI Tukai in particular as the Home For The Gods!

It was not until 1996 that the lodge opened its doors. It is designed to take full advantage of its rare environment. The endless plains dominate one side while the other is lavished with a forest of indigenous acacia trees.

ACCOMMODATION: There are 80 luxury chalet-style twin rooms at OI Tukai Lodge, all with an uninterrupted view of the wetlands or Kilimanjaro. Stylish and comfortable, the rooms have private bath rooms and individual terraces. They are equipped with safes, fans, tea and coffee counters. To accommodate physically challenged guests, two rooms have been designed according to EU standards.

RESTAURANTS/BARS: The dining room features an intricately designed sisal tapestry by a local artist, depicting the Maasai people. Just meters from elephants and other game that venture close to the boundary, the dining room opens onto a veranda in the garden where lunch is usually served.

POOL BAR: The pool bar serves snacks and drinks between meal times. Our pool waiters are pleased to assist you, and our barman can make you a special fruit punch while you soak up the sun.

ELEPHANT BAR: The Elephant Bar is situated between the lounge and the dining room. This open-air bar serves a wide selection of beers, cocktails, liquors and fresh juices. Above the bar, a roof-level deck offers a splendid panorama of the marshlands and Mt. Kilimanjaro.

RECREATION FACILITIES

SWIMMING POOL: Before your afternoon game drive, why not take a cooling dip or lounge by the pool under the acacia shade?

BOARD GAMES: Scrabble, Monopoly, cards and many other games are available from reception.

EXCURSIONS & ACTIVITIES

GAME DRIVES: Vehicles can be booked for game drives through Nairobi Office or directly at the lodge.

MAASAI DANCING: A troupe of Maasai Moran warriors will entertain you with traditional songs and dances after dinner at about 9.15pm, on alternate evenings.

BIRD WALKS: OI Tukai is home to 400 species of beautiful African birds. Enjoy the short bird walk that starts at the entrance of the hotel and rambles under the canopy of acacia trees around the lodge. A must for any fledgling ornithologist!

LECTURES: Lecturers from Elephant Research regularly give interesting, informative lectures at the Lodge.

FACILITIES

BUREAU DE CHANGE: The cashier can exchange reasonable amounts of foreign currency.

CREDIT CARDS: All major credit cards are accepted at OI Tukai.

CHILDREN: Children are welcome at OI Tukai. Most bedrooms are easily large enough to accommodate an extra bed. A children's menu and early supper is available and security guards patrol while parents enjoy their dinner.

COMMUNICATION: OI Tukai has 24 hour telephone, WIFI internet services and a business centre

CONFERENCE FACILITIES: OI Tukai's conference room is fully equipped with video, flip charts, projector and other relevant apparatus.

The room can accommodate up to 200 delegates and the management is happy to cater for specific seating requirements.

MULTI DENOMINATIONAL CHAPEL:

Services are held every Sunday and all are welcome. Our multi denominational chapel is a wonderful place to tie the knot or renew marriage vows. A special wedding package can be offered and arrangements made with our head office in Nairobi prior to arrival.

SHOP: Browse through our shop for souvenirs and memorabilia. Toiletries and other personal necessities are also available.

FIRE SAFETY: Familiarise yourself with the notice behind your room's door for evacuation information in case of a fire emergency.

CLINIC: Our resident nurse operates a clinic for guests, staff, and the local community within the park. In case of an emergency, the lodge will arrange for evacuation to a hospital in Nairobi.
