



Moving along the banks of the great Chobe River, Zambezi Queen is a 5-star, 42-metre long luxury houseboat offering unparalleled sophistication in one of the most remote locations on the planet. Zambezi Queen navigates up to 25km of the Chobe River, allowing guests to explore different vantage points and enjoy unparalleled game viewing in complete comfort and elegance.

The Chobe National Park boasts one of the densest populations of elephant on the African continent, estimated at approximately 120 000. The Park is also home to a large number of buffalo, leopard and lion, along with a variety of antelope and abundant birdlife and is within travelling distance of one of the greatest natural wonders of the world, the magnificent Victoria Falls.

Best time to travel

There is no best or worst time to visit the Chobe area, because every month offers visitors something special. However, if guests are looking for a pure wildlife experience, the drier winter months from June to August see greater concentrations of game along the banks of the Chobe River. The summer months from November to May see the birdlife explode with the addition of the summer migrants to the area. If you're a fishing enthusiast, you'll be excited to know that we have excellent fishing through the summer and winter—it's just that the techniques we use change.

Access

Zambezi Queen is moored on the Namibian side of the Chobe River. Here's information on how to reach the vessel:

By Car:

If you're on a self-drive safari, secure parking can be arranged for your vehicles next to the Kasane Immigration Office. The GPS co-ordinates are \$ 17° 46′ 48" / E 025° 11′ 23". Please advise at time of booking whether you require secure parking.

By Air:

There are four main access points by air:

- Kasane International Airport, Botswana (BBK) is about 15 minutes from Kasane Immigration Office
- Victoria Falls Airport, Zimbabwe (VFA) is about 1 ½ hours from Kasane Immigration Office
- Harry Mwanga Nkumbula International Airport, formerly Livingstone Airport, Zambia (LVI) is about 2 hours from Kasane Immigration Office
- Katima Mulilo Airport, Namibia (MPA) is about 2 ½ hours from Kasane Immigration Office

Arrival & departure procedure

- Once guests arrive at Kasane Immigration Office, a Zambezi Queen Collection staff member will help with their luggage as well as formalities at passport control as guests exit Botswana
- A Zambezi Queen Collection staff member will then transfer guests by motorised boat to the Namibian Immigration Office, where they'll get their passport stamped. Guests are advised to wear comfortable shoes, a hat and sunscreen as there is a short walk to the immigration office
- · Both Kasane and Namibian immigration offices open at 07h30 and close at 16h30 daily
- Should guests know beforehand that they'll arrive at KIO before 13h00 on the day of their arrival, please notify our
 reservations office 48 hours before arrival
- Collection is from 13h00 on day of arrival
- Drop off is from 8h30 on day of departure





Accommodation

Zambezi Queen offers luxury accommodation in the form of 14 tasteful and luxurious suites - ten standard suites and four master suites, all with outer decks so you can soak up the revitalising Chobe River breeze and appreciate uninterrupted views of the unique African landscape beyond.

The suites are located on the lower and middle deck and can be configured as follows:

Lower deck:

- 2 master suites twin or double bed configuration accommodating 2 adults
- 2 standard suites twin or double bed configuration accommodating 2 adults

Middle deck:

- 2 master suites twin or double bed configuration accommodating 2 adults
- 8 standard suites twin or double bed configuration accommodating 2 adults
- 2 standard triple suites three single beds or double with one single bed configuration accommodating 3 adults
- 1 tour guide cabin single bed configuration

All suites are equipped with:

- Private balconies
- Full length sliding shutters

- Zambezi Queen accepts children from age 7 and older accompanied by an adult. Triple suites are available for children sharing with their parents, with a maximum of one child persuite
- If you're bringing more than one child, you'll need to book an additional suite for every two children that accompany you
- Please note that no separate activities and/or menus are available for children
- Children 16 years and older are subject to adult rates on the Zambezi Queen

Visa requirements

Because our houseboats are situated in a malaria area, we advise that you take malaria prophylactics. Please consult your doctor before travelling for up-to-date medical advice.




