







Zarafa Camp, located in the 320,000-acre Selinda Reserve is synonymous with exclusivity and perfection. The spirit behind Zarafa Camp comes from the founders of Great Plains, who together pooled their collective experience to create what they deemed to be the best and most environmentally innovative camp. Positioned in the extreme eastern side of the Reserve in prime wildlife territory, Botswana's first and only Relais δ Chateaux property consists of four immense tented suites raised on wooden decking and shaded by a canopy of African ebony and Red ivory trees, each with uninterrupted views of the crystal waters of Zibadianja Lagoon. Afternoon excursions on HES Zib, the camp's pontoon boat, often include exquisite sightings.
