

Directions to Zimanga Private Game Reserve

The Zimanga Private Game Reserve Main Entrance is well-marked on Google Maps on the N2 National Highway, around 8km north of Mkuze town. One of our staff members will meet you at the main entrance. Please contact the lodge manager should you experience delays or expect to arrive early.

Please plan your travelling to arrive at 12 noon from May to September.

Please plan your travelling to arrive at 1pm from October to April.

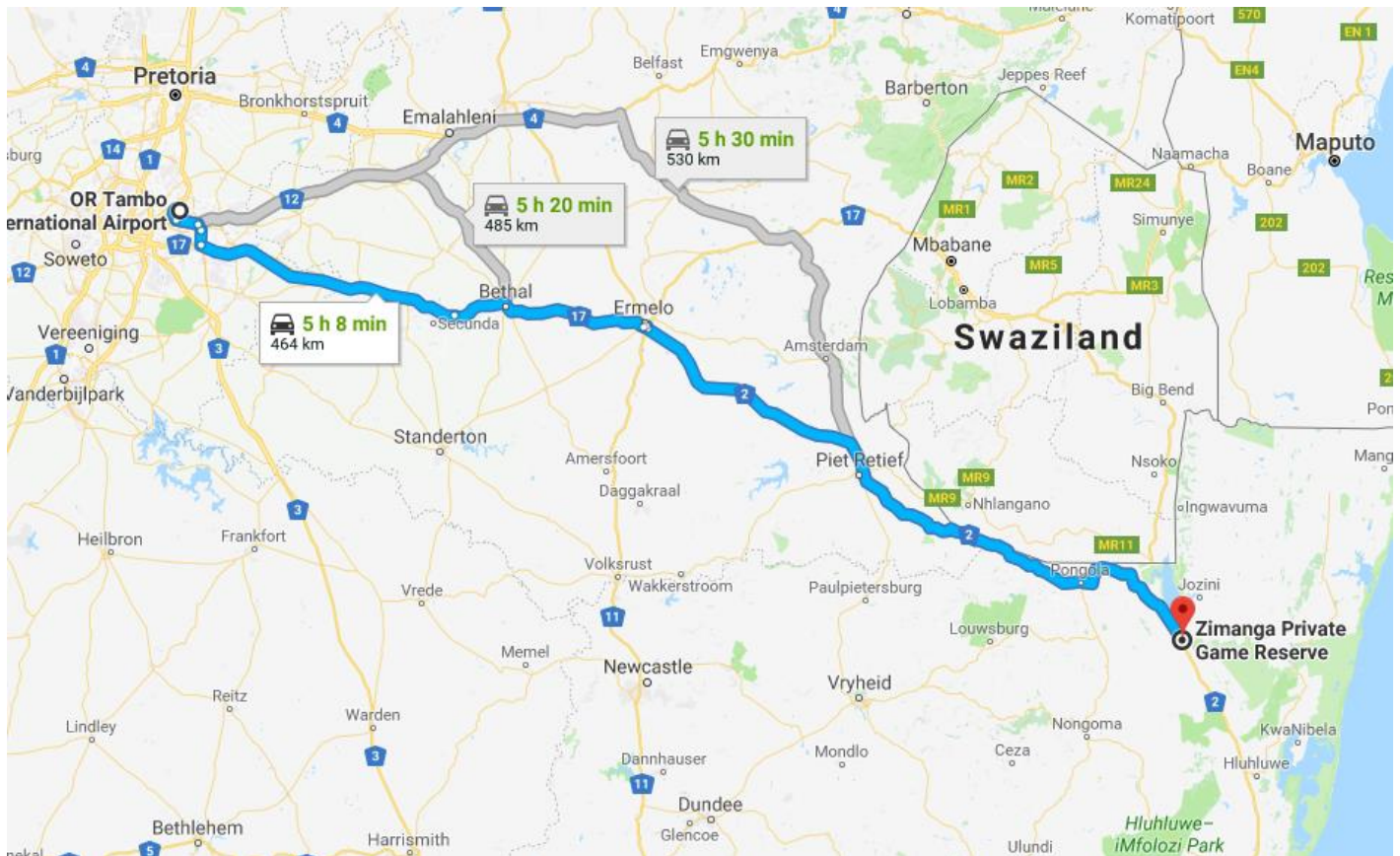

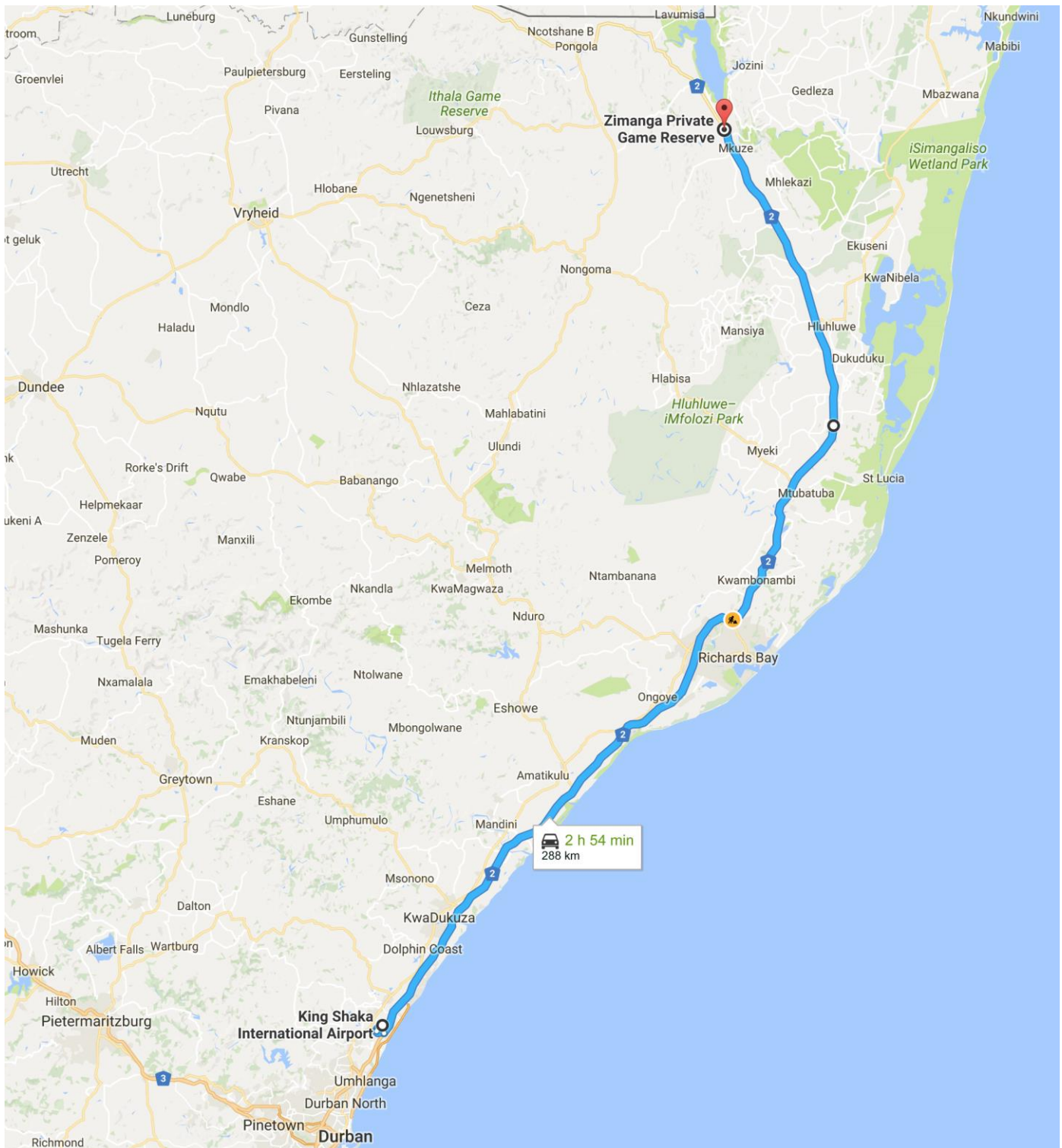
Travelling from Gauteng/Mpumalanga

The route from Johannesburg is via Ermelo, Piet Retief, Pongola. The road is prone to delays and travel time realistically takes 6-9 hours. An early departure around 6am is recommended to be in time for the first afternoon activity.

Please note that the road between Ermelo and Piet Retief is full of potholes and is not always easy to see. Also, the road between Piet Retief and Pongola has a lot of coal trucks and the road surface is also very uneven with potholes.



Travelling from Kwazulu Natal / Durban



This route from Durban has a 3 hour travelling time along a busy but predictable, well-maintained national highway. Delays along the route are infrequent. Travel north on the N2.

Please note:

We are still waiting for the Roads Authority to give the Zimanga Entrance an official “turning lane”. There are currently no sign posts on the road. Please do not expect a sign or turning lane.

From Durban: The gate is on your left and it is easy and safe to turn.

From Jozini/Pongola: Please take extra care as you will need to make a right turn to the entrance across the on-coming lane.
