Tlouwana Camp is owner and run and managed, and is aimed at the affordable luxury travel markets across the world, offering great value for money and a unique classical safari experience. Tlouwana Camp will appeal to the novice safari guest as well as to the seasoned safari traveller.

ABOUT US

Tlouwana camp is a couple owned and run safari camp situated in Lesoma northern Botswana, overlooking the Matetsi reserve with all your needs in one place to explore the Chobe region. Conveniently located close to Kasane international airport and a 20-minute drive to the entrance of the Chobe National Park, Kasane town, Zambia and Zimbabwe borders.

TLOUWANA CAMP THEME,

The camp is built in the classic SAFARI style, with luxury safari tents, en-suite bathrooms and living areas, not forgetting the romantic outdoor showers. All the tents are situated on raised pine decking and the pathways to the tents meander between the large Jackal berry and Acacia trees.

WHERE IS TLOUWANA CAMP LOCATED?

Camp is situated in the game rich Chobe area known for its huge abundant elephant herds. The Chobe National park located on the doorstep and guided wildlife activities are part of an everyday lifestyle when staying with us.

INCLUDED & EXCLUDED IN OUR RATES?

- Rates are fully inclusive of accommodation, all meals, laundry, lodge activities, return vehicle airport, Zimbabwe, Zambia borders and Kasane town transfers, alcoholic & non-alcoholic beverages, levies & taxes
- Rates exclude, international flights, internal flight transfers, travel insurance, items of a personal nature, visas and discretionary gratuities.

GETTING TO TLOUWANA CAMP

Access to Tlouwana Camp is by land and Air or One can self-drive alternatively.

- Tlouwana Camp is a 20 - 25-minute drive from the following points, Kasane Airport, Kasane Town, Zimbabwe and Zambia border posts.

Self-drives are also an option to get to camp but do recommend a 4x4 vehicle getting there.

NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE ACCOMMODATION

- Luxury tented camp – 9 Tents in Total – Max 22 guests – 4 doubles and 3 twin units, and 2 Superior family units.
- Children of all ages welcome. A private vehicle is required for children under 12 years old participating in game activities

NOTES ABOUT SHARING AND CHILDREN:

1. Children aged 5 years and younger stay free, children 5-17 yrs pay standard child rate (50% of adult sharing rate). Children 18+ yrs pay full adult rate.
3. One child and one adult in standard luxury tent pay adult + child rate.

WHAT TO DO

- Afternoon game drives into Chobe National Park
- Walking (guide dependant and time of year)
- Morning boat cruises into Chobe National Park
- Game viewing from the comfort of your own tent
- Catch up on some reading, and relaxing at the pool
- Visits to the local community of Lesoma Valley Village
- After Dinner Night Drive

A TYPICAL DAY

A typical summer day: (Kindly note times may vary slightly and winter timings are different)
05h30 Wakeup call at the room 06h00 Light breakfast in the main area 06h30 Depart for your morning activity: Boat Cruise into the Chobe National Park, Return from morning activity 11h00

Brunch Afternoon at leisure – possible activities: Swimming pool, curio shop or village tour
14h30 Afternoon Tea 15h00 Depart on afternoon game drive 19h30 Return from game drive 19h00 Dinner under the stars weather permitting.

After dinner: optional night drive

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Tlouwana Camp is built on a pine decking platform and has wheelchair friendly access only in tent 1 with the rest of our facilities wheel chair friendly.
- Because Botswana is a malaria area, precautions are recommended. All travellers coming from or going through countries which have been declared yellow fever infected areas must provide an international health certificate of vaccination for yellow fever upon arrival into Botswana.
- The water in camp is safe to drink, but mineral water will be supplied.
- Tlouwana Camp has 220V 50hz 24-hour plug points in all the tents which can be used to charge batteries, sleep apnoea machines, hair dryers and kettles.
- There is no WIFI in the tents or main areas but WIFI can be accessed in the public reception.
- No children under 12 allowed to participate in Walking activities.

WHAT TO PACK?

Clothing on safari should be comfortable and colours should blend in with nature as much as possible. Beige, greens, browns, tan and khaki coloured clothing is advisable. Evening dress is 'smart casual', no formal wear required.

YEAR ROUND

- Layers – the best way to dress on safari, due to fluctuating temperatures. We recommend cotton. Long sleeves and trousers will protect from both sun and insects.
- Fleece/warm sweater or warm jacket for morning and evening game drives
- Hat – broad brimmed for protection against the sun.
- Sunglasses – dark ones to cut the glare.
- Light cotton shirts and T-shirts; Blouses or shirts
- Shorts, trousers and longs
- Shoes – good, comfortable sturdy closed shoes/boots and socks for walking.
- Flip flops/thongs for use on the Victoria falls day trip.
- Sunblock, insect repellent and lip salve.
- Binoculars – each person should have their own so as not to miss out on any sightings.
- Camera with spare batteries, memory sticks, film, and the correct charging apparatus.
