 Being sensitive to local customs is always important. In hotels and lodges, almost any dress code is acceptable.



 On certain city streets, beaches and rural communities you should dress and behave more conservatively in respect of the local culture, particularly in Islamic parts of East Africa.



 Please respect attitudes of the locals towards photography and only use cameras if you have permission to do so. Never try to take a photo against the will of the person concerned, rather let your guide negotiate terms before you start taking photographs.



 It's a good rule of thumb to never take photographs of border posts, military installations, persons in uniform or at airports.
