



Customs & Etiquettes

- Being sensitive to local customs is always important. In hotels and lodges, almost any dress code is acceptable.
- On certain city streets, beaches and rural communities you should dress and behave more conservatively in respect of the local culture, particularly in Islamic parts of East Africa.
- Please respect attitudes of the locals towards photography and only use cameras if you have permission to do so. Never try to take a photo against the will of the person concerned, rather let your guide negotiate terms before you start taking photographs.
- It's a good rule of thumb to never take photographs of border posts, military installations, persons in uniform or at airports.
