

Directions to Rhino Post Safari Lodge and collection point for Plains Camp @ Rhino Walking Safaris from NUMBI GATE (KRUGER NATIONAL PARK):

- Once through the gate you will travel on the H1-1 road for 42km. You will reach a T-junction, turn left towards Skukuza +- 13km.
- You will reach a four-way crossing, turn right for another 2 km until you reach a T-junction.
- Turn left at this junction and continue for approximately 1km until you reach another four-way crossing, turn right (onto the H1-2). You will cross a low water bridge (over Sabie River), approximately 4 km later you will cross the Sand River.
- Keep heading straight, past the dirt road on the left signposted Maroela Loop, 6 km further, you will pass another dirt road, also signposted Maroela Loop.
- Approximately 1km after the second dirt road you will see a dirt road on the left signposted Rhino Walking Safaris.
- Take this turning and proceed for 2.5km, the road will then turn sharply left, after which you will travel another 2.7km, leading you directly to Rhino Post. Safari Lodge.

Afternoon tea is at 15h30 and the game drive departs at 16h00

## Plains Camp @ Rhino Walking Safaris

Guests arriving after 14h00 will be obliged to spend their first night at Rhino Post Safari Lodge or if the lodge is full, wait at Rhino Post until 19h30/20h00 for a late transfer over to Plains Camp.
