CHEM CHEM LODGE, LITTLE CHEM CHEM & FOREST CHEM CHEM



OVERVIEW

- Chem Chem Safaris comprises of three leading luxury eco-camps: Chem Chem Lodge, Little Chem Chem and the exclusive-use camp, Forest Chem Chem.
- Located in 20,000ha of exclusive use land within the Burunge Wildlife Management Area (WMA) between the Tarangire National Park in the east and Lake Manyara in the west.
- Privately owned & managed by Fabia Bausch & Nicolas Negre.
- The concept of "Slow Safari" was born at Chem Chem Lodge. The ethos of a safari being a tangible, sensual experience beyond the confines of a vehicle.

LOCATION

CHEM CHEM LODGE

Chem Chem Lodge lies on the north-western part of the Burunge WMA, adjacent to Lake Manyara.

LITTLE CHEM CHEM & FOREST CHEM CHEM

Little Chem Chem and Forest Chem Chem are located in the south-eastern part of the Burunge WMA which borders over 25km of the Tarangire National Park.

ACCESS

BY AIR:

- Chem Chem Airstrip: Easy connections with other safari airstrips & airports. 10-minute road transfer from Chem Chem Lodge; 40-minute transfer from Little Chem Chem or Forest Chem Chem
- The closest international airport is Kilimanjaro (3 hours' drive).
- Arusha Airport and Lake Manyara Airport: a 2 hour drive to Chem Chem Lodge and a 2.5 hour drive to Little Chem Chem or Forest Chem Chem.

BY ROAD TO / FROM: Chem Chem Lodge:

Arusha Airport: 2 hours (road transfer)
Manyara Airstrip: 2 hours (road transfer)
Kilimanjaro Airport: 3 hours (road transfer)

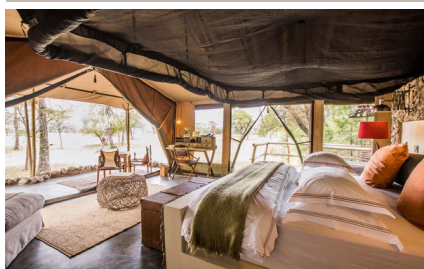
BY ROAD TO / FROM: Little & Forest Chem Chem

*For any reason that aircrafts are unable to land on our airstrip such as weather, flooding, earth tremors, etc, then we will divert flights to Manyara or Kuro airstrips and transfer guests by road at no additional cost.

GIVING BACK	<p>Chem Chem Safaris is passionate about Tanzania's economic and social development and, through our association, is proud to contribute to local community empowerment efforts.</p> <p>The Chem Chem Association (CCA) believes that the path to sustainable conservation lies in educating – and inspiring – the next generation of environmental advocates and empowering our communities through alternative income-generating pathways that incentivise the protection of wildlife. To do this, we aim to give our communities the tools they need to take up the mantle of conservation. This includes supporting education initiatives – such as maintaining state school infrastructure, offering teachers courses, and providing children with environmental education – in our communities in collaboration with teachers and local stakeholders.</p> <p>The restoration and ongoing protection of the Kwakuchinja Corridor, a vital wildlife migratory route linking the Tarangire and Lake Manyara national parks, has been a priority for CCA since its inception. And, while the corridor – once on the brink of extinction – is now a haven for migrating wildlife, our work is far from done. To ensure the continued protection of this crucial ecosystem, we must continue to work closely with local communities and government agencies to foster a peaceful coexistence between humans and wildlife in the region.</p> <p>Furthermore, the CCA, in partnership with Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA), Tanzania Wildlife Management Authority (TAWA), police forces, and BWMA law enforcement officers, supports a joint anti-poaching team of rangers who patrol the concession on foot and by vehicle to protect the precious wildlife that calls the Kwakuchinja Corridor home.</p>
