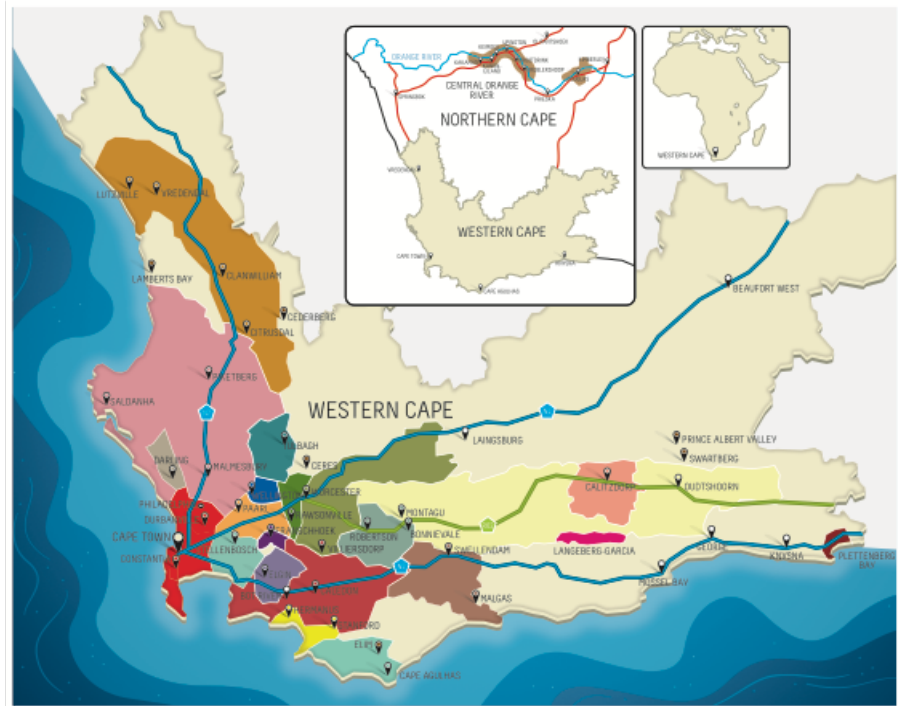

The Winelands of South Africa

The Cape winelands stretch from the rugged mountains and multi-directional slopes of the coastal regions to open plains of the Little Karoo where viticulture takes place mainly in the riverine valleys. South African vineyards are mostly situated in the Western Cape near the coast. However, there are another five geographical units that exist outside of this area, namely Eastern Cape, Free State, KwaZulu-Natal, Limpopo and Northern Cape.

Certification

Because Three Tree Hill holds the **Fair Trade Tourism (FTT)** certification stamp, we strongly believe in procuring sustainable goods & choose wines that have a similar ethical code to ours. Where possible, we select Fair Trade, Organic, Biodynamic, Woman-made, Black-owned and do not serve any imported wines.

Below are some of the certification labels that we look out for when making our choices.

The statutory certification seal of the **Wine and Spirit Board (WSB)** is an absolute guarantee to the public that the claims made on the packaging about the wine are true and that the wine was of good quality when it was evaluated by the Wine and Spirit Board for certification. As such, it is very important to wine lovers. A wine can only be certified when all the requirements of the Wine of Origin Scheme have been met. Only certified wines may claim origin, cultivar or vintage.



South Africa was at the forefront of developing an industry-wide Sustainability Seal. Issued by the WSB. Integrated Production of Wine (IPW) is a voluntary environmental sustainability scheme established by the South African wine industry. In order to achieve this Sustainability Seal the winery must ensure the health & safety of their workers, use limited chemicals & pesticides, introduce natural predators onto their farms, clean up waste water & they must protect the biodiversity of the world's richest Floral Kingdom. They are audited every 3 years. **Sustainable Wine South Africa (SWSA)** is the alliance between the Wine and Spirit Board (WSB), the Integrated Production of Wine (IPW) scheme and Wines of South Africa (WoSA). Together these organisations are driving the South African wine industry's commitment to sustainable, eco-friendly production.



Through a voluntary membership model, World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) works with the environmental leaders in SA's wine industry, known as the **Conservation Champions (CC)**. These landowners commit to biodiversity-friendly and regenerative farming practices, conserve their natural areas and continually improve their water and energy efficiencies.



The **Confronting Climate Change (CCC) Carbon Heroes** initiative is a carbon footprinting project, developed to support SA's wine and fruit sectors through identifying and responding to the risks and opportunities associated with carbon emissions.



Fair Trade (FT) is the most trusted ethical certification in the world. Fair Trade standards aim to reduce poverty and empower small-scale farmers and farm workers by ensuring better trading, working, living conditions and supporting sustainable production and protection of the environment.



The **V-Label (V)** is an internationally recognised, registered symbol for labelling vegan and vegetarian products and services. For consumers, it is a simple and reliable guide to help them when they are shopping. With the V-Label, companies promote transparency and clarity.

A Chenin Blanc fortified spirit gently sweetened by the sugar of the grapes, bittered by Quinchona bark & flavoured with 35 truly Cape ingredients such as Fynbos, Kalmoes & Naartjies. By itself it's excellent, but mixed with gin is refreshing. This is known as "Gin & Cape" The original Spion Kop cocktail mix is half Caperitif, half French Vermouth.

Haute Cabriere Ratafia R70

Franschhoek

Ratafia is a fun drink, packed with rich honey flavours. A great aperitif made from 100% Chardonnay fortified with Pierre Jourdan Fine de Jourdan (brandy) Serve chilled.

WINE BY THE GLASS

What follows below is merely a guide to help you choose a glass of wine. Should you require a taste of something else from the list, please feel free to ask your waitron.

2019 Pierre Jourdan Brut R88

MCC with sweet entry, shy apple flavours and brisk finish.

2021 Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc R45

Uncomplicated off dry blend of Sauvignon Blanc & and Chenin with a splash of Riesling

2021 Trizanne Signature Wines (TSW) Sauvignon Blanc R65

Vibrant & fresh note of passion fruit, citrus & subtle herbal notes with a distinct minerality expected from this cooler climate wine.

Energetic palate, which finishes off on a dry, clean and very classy note.

2021 DMZ Chardonnay R65

Nectarine & peach aromas, with subtle citrus hints & creamy oak finish. Grapes in this vineyard are serenaded by Baroque music to encourage healthy growth.

2021 Dawn Patrol Cinsault Rosé R55

Displays flavours of wild strawberries, floral undertones & mouth-watering pomegranate, complimented with a fantastic dry finish.

2020 Reyneke Organic Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon R50

Fruit is rich and pure, but has an old-world feel in its savoury, complex long, dry finish.

2019 Org de Rac Organic Cabernet R65

Distinctive aromas of tomato leaf, pencil shavings and mulberry beckon on the nose. A rich and well - rounded wine with sumptuous dark fruit flavours supported by velvety tannins.

2020 Lyngrove Merlot R50

Classic style of Merlot with labels of soft berry fruits on the nose and palate, with a smooth velvety tannin structure. Very accessible wine with fresh acidity and lingering spices on the finish.

SPARKLING WINES

Under agreement with France, South Africa does not use the term “Champagne” which is actually a geographic appellation describing the sparkling wines from the Champagne region in France. In South Africa the term METHOD CAP CLASSIQUE (MCC) is rather used.

MCC describes Sparkling Wines made by the classic Methode Champenoise.

Enjoy these MCC's with our Seafood and Lemongrass Soup or
Drakensberg Smoked Trout Crepes.

2017 Simonsig Cuveé Royale R800

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

The finesse, purity & power of Chardonnay find expression in this grand style of Blanc de Blanc. Creamy, dry elegance with cinnamon and toast.

Colmant Brut Rosé NV R700

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★) (WSB)

Delightful blend of Pinot Noir (80%) and Chardonnay (20%) with a minimum 24 months on the lees. This MCC is macerated on the skins to give the Brut Rose its colour and signature berry aroma and flavour. Elegant, with silky richness & vibrant colour that reflects the fresh notes of wild strawberries & red currants.

2018 Abingdon Pet-Nat R465

KwaZulu Natal Midlands

Pet-Nat stands for petillant-naturel – a wine that's bottled before the fermentation is complete. The result is a sparkling wine that has less fizz than champagne but tastes just as good. Perfumed floral nose of violets, subtle apricots, white peach and pear drop on the palate.

2019 Pierre Jourdan Brut R335

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

Classic blend of chardonnay & pinot noir.

Salty tang to zesty apple & lemon flavours, creamy mid-palate with raspberry finish.

WHITE BLENDS

2020 Cape Point Isliedh R700

Cape Peninsula ((Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

Pronounced (ai-lay). This Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon blend displays a silky, grippy finesse, combining lightness of texture with depth of flavour. Made for ageing.

2017 Bizoe Henriëtta R350

Somerset West (Platter ★★★★★☆) (WSB)

Judiciously oaked Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc blend. Wisps of orange peel on the palate, fresh tropical fruit aroma & a delicate aftertaste derived from being matured in oak barrels for 7 months. Limited edition of 2700 bottles.

2021 Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc R180

Constantia (Platter ★★☆☆) (WSB)

Uncomplicated dry blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin with a splash of Riesling. Combines green notes with more tropical tones: cut grass & gooseberries, kiwi ending in mineral-freshness.

CHENIN BLANC

Chenin is the Cape's signature variety, with the largest planting of this variety in the world.

Smoky sweet Sunday Gammon will match well with these wines.

2020 Stellenrust 56 Barrel Fermented Chenin Blanc R585

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (FT) (SWSA)

56 year old bush vines from Bottelary produce a dramatic wine, fermented with wild yeast & spending 9 months in the barrel. Pure, rich & refined, apricot, marmalade & cashew cream vivacity with beautiful layers of complexity. Restrained oak with long, honeyed finish.

2020 Kumusha Chenin Blanc R250

Breedekloof (Platter ★★☆☆) (WSB)

Aromas of pear, white peach & lime on the nose. Juicy palate with flavours of melon & matamba (monkey orange) with crisp, dry finish.

2021 Cederberg Chenin Blanc R220

Citrusdal (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA) (CC)

South Africa's highest lying vineyards (1036m above sea level) near the coastal windswept of Elim, make this chenin truly unique. Zesty chenin with notes of lemon & grapefruit & a hint of tropical sweet melon. Creamy sensation with a crisp finish.

2021 Marras Chenin Blanc R195

Piekenierskloof (Platter ★★☆☆) (SWSA)

Juicy pear & quince on the palate with baking spice aftertaste.

Rich, but perfectly balanced.

VIOGNIER

Can be enjoyed with roast pork and crispy crackling, homemade chicken pie or pasta.

2020 Tamboerskloof (Kleinood) Viognier R410

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

Frangipani, jasmine and citrus blossom flavours on the nose, which are well supported by apple, peach and citrus on the palate

2020 Lismore Age of Grace Viognier R500

Greyton (Platter ★★★★★) (BSW)

Beautiful perfume of honeysuckle & orange blossom, with a textured palate of apricot, kiwi & pineapple. A sensual & exotic experience, made by a woman, barrel-fermented & aged.

GEWÜRZTRAMINER

Best served with traditional Malay-spiced Bobotie dish.

2019 Simonsig Gewürztraminer R235

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

The first cellar to release a Gewürztraminer in South Africa, which is notoriously difficult to grow. Lush tropical fruit & rich spice aromas. Exotic tastes of litchi, Turkish delight & roses. Juicy, well-balanced sweetness with a clean, lingering aftertaste.

PINOT GRIGIO/GRIS

Drakensberg Smoked Trout Pate will compliment this wine.

2020 Anthonij Rupert Terra del Capo Pinot Grigio R170

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA) (CC)

Richly honeyed, dry white wine, which is well balanced with macadamia nut nougat, some yellow apple fruit & Granny Smith acidity.

RIESLING

Grilled Root Vegetable Quiche and Goats Cheese will compliment your Riesling well.

2016 Jordan “The Real Mc Coy” Riesling R365

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

Intense lime & aromatic tropical fruit flavours,

balanced by a crisp, fruit acidity & a spicy complexity.

2017 Spioenkop Riesling R500

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★☆) (BSW)

Dry Alsace style. Aromatics of grape fruit and lime, and the palate is 'tightly wound with punchy acidity and a very dry finish' or 'dense, pithy and wonderfully racy and pure'.

2022 Saurwine Chi Riesling R500

Elgin (SWSA)

Chi means 'life force' and stands for Chiuta (an African rain god) Fragrant orange blossom, green melon, lime. Yellow stone fruits, honeysuckle and flint.

SEMILLON

Drakensberg Smoked Trout Crepes served with a
Dill Dressing will do well with this wine.

2017 Shannon Semillon R475

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

Naturally fermented Semillon, which is round on entry, then dense
& concentrated in the middle. My absolute favourite white wine in the world!

VERDELHO

Fresh oysters, shellfish or duck roulade would go so well with this, we can only dream?

2019 Org de Rac Organic Verdelho R230

Piketberg (Platter ★★★★★☆) (100% Organic) (SWSA) (V)

Delightfully balanced, fresh but lightly rich with citric acidity and a hint of honey & subtle
gingery spice.

COLOMBARD

Best enjoyed with Pork Sirloin Steaks and Apple Ginger Sauce

2020 Lowerland Vaalkameel Colombard R625

Prieska (Platter ★★★★★☆) (100% Organic) (BSW)

Fresh, fruity, yet fully rounded with red apple skin aromas followed by stone fruit component and ginger spice on the nose with gentle, long & white peachy finish.

CHARDONNAY

(Wooded)

Roast chicken, lentil curry and bootie dishes go well with Chardonnay.

2019 Hogan The Galvanised Chardonnay R475

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

Wonderful purity with aromas of melon, parma ham, nutmeg and papaya. Great fruit concentration, light grapefruit citrus freshness, restrained oak and delicate lees creaminess giving harmonious balance. Woman-made.

2017 Hartenberg Chardonnay R330

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA)

Crisp, yet creamy. Citrus, chalky toast & clean minerality.

2019 Glen Carlou Chardonnay R330

Paarl (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA) (CC)

Tangy citrus notes with crispy apple fruit. Barrel ferment gives toast & biscuit nuances before a lipsmacking lemony finish.

2021 DMZ Chardonnay R250

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (SWSA) (CC)

Subtle white peach & pear with deft oaking adds succulent toasty nuance with clean lemon & lime farewell.

Grapes in this vineyard are serenaded by Baroque music to encourage healthy growth.

(Un-Wooded)

2018 Bouchard Finlayson Sans Barrique Chardonnay R400

Elandskloof (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA) (CC)

Crafted in a Burgundian style for wine lovers who like their Chardonnay unhindered by the taste of oak. White peach & grainy pear, crushed seashell notes, salty minerality, while lively acid gives an upbeat finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Always suited to enjoying with lunch time home grown salads and our famous fish pie.

2020 Fryers Cove Bamboes Bay Sauvignon Blanc R745

Bamboes Bay, West Coast (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

Invigorating sea-inflected intensity in greenage, lemongrass, passionfruit array. Taut & bracingly racy, balanced by the underlying weight. On the nose this wine is a vibrant mix of clean, herbaceous and tangy passion fruit aromas, with briny wisps of seaweed in the background.

2021 Cape Point Noordhoek Sauvignon Blanc R290

Noordhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

Consistently refined, smooth texture with clean-cut freshness. Subtly intense range of riper greener flavours, a kernel of sweet peachy fruit to its brightly succulent dryness. The palate is rich and full made in a style to be a wonderful food companion.

2021 Aslina Sauvignon Blanc R275

Stellenbosch (SWSA)

Ntsiki Biyela grew up in Mahlabathini, a rural village in KwaZulu-Natal, and matriculated from high school in 1996. Having spent a year as a domestic worker, she was awarded a scholarship to study winemaking at Stellenbosch University, and eventually graduated in 2003 with a BSc in Agriculture (Viticulture and Oenology) Her beloved grandmother was the guiding light in her life and it became obvious that her new brand should be named Aslina in the matriarch's honour.

A full rounded tropical character sauvignon blanc with complex bright fruit and lots of citrus characters. Lemon zest, with beautiful complexity and depth and a lingering silky finish.

2020 Trizanne Signature Wines (TSW) Sauvignon Blanc R260

Elim (Platter ★★★☆) (SWSA)

Vibrant & fresh note of passion fruit, citrus & subtle herbal notes with a distinct minerality expected from this cooler climate woman-made wine.

Energetic palate, which finishes off on a dry, crisp and very classy note.

ROSE WINES

2021 Delaire Graff Cabernet Franc Rosé R250

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★☆) (SWSA)

Made from 100% Cabernet Franc, this unique rose displays flavors of red berries & cream, satisfying balance of weight with pleasing dryness.

2021 Dawn Patrol Cinsault Rosé R210

Swartland (Platter ★★★☆) (SWSA)

Tangy strawberry & raspberry appeal.

Prieska (Platter ★★★★★☆)(100% Organic) (SWSA)

Berene Sauls grew up in a small village called Tesselaarsdal, situated 24 km North East of the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley, Hermanus, in the Overberg region. Tesselaarsdal has a unique history: in 1810, Johannes Tesselaar bequeathed his farmland to his servants and slaves. She named her wine Tesselaarsdal to honour that legacy.

Gin Verdant is floral and soft with a translucent golden-green hue. Delicate aromas reminiscent of elderflower and chamomile, lead to summer blooms, a touch of spice, subtle juniper, waxy lemon rind and alluring liquorice on the palate. Serve with cinnamon stick & slice of raw ginger.

Gin Amber is a rich and aromatic, amber coloured gin with fresh citrus, slight juniper, sweet toffee apples and delicate floral notes which intertwine to deliver a dry, woody finish. Serve with pink peppercorns, strawberries & orange zest.

Musgrave Pink R60

the rose, rosehip, which complement Musgrave's spicy nature. It is then infused with rose water for its timeless perfume and romance.

Clemengold R60

The sweet and sun-ripened essence of ClemenGold, SA's leading mandarin, now treats gin aficionados to a classic Cape Dry style gin with subtle hints of citrus. Nine botanicals – with sundried ClemenGold peels taking the flavour lead – are used when distilling this superb gin in the heart of Cape Town. ClemenGold and orange peel, cinnamon, honey, ground almond, juniper berries, angelica and orris root, and coriander are macerated and vapour-infused. Serve with fresh thyme & orange peel.

6 Dogs Blue R60

Hex River Valley

This distillery started in a shed, housing 6 dogs & an old copper geyser converted into a still. The Blue variety contains Clitoris Ternatea (Blue Pea Flower), an antioxidant & aphrodisiac in traditional medicine.

031 D'Urban Scarlet & Dry R60

Durban

The world's first gin made with cascara (coffee cherries). This exciting gin is crafted in small batches using cascara sourced from Beaver Creek Coffee Estate on the KZN South Coast. Cascara is the red, fleshy covering around the coffee bean, and adds subtle berry notes to the gin without being overpowering.

Pienaar & Sons Empire R60

Cape Town

Situated a stones' thrown from Parliament, this distillery has used newly, hand built, locally produced engineering principles to distill their special spirit. Made from South African maize, this gin shows fresh hints of citrus, pine notes of juniper & Angelica root. Serve with a dash of honey & star aniseed.

Triple 3 Just Juniper R60

Stellenbosch

The ripe juniper berries used for this gin boast a broad array of aromas. Fresh essential oil fragrances like menthol, eucalyptus, pine, cloves and lime are gently emphasised by whiffs of white pepper. Notes of vanilla and the floral scent of rose

petals reflect the sweet juiciness juniper naturally carries. This 100% Juniper Berry Gin captivates with its smooth fullness and menthol-like herby whiffs served with a stimulating citrus touch. Dry spicy notes join the interplay of aromas.

Cape Town Rooibos Red R60

Cape Town

To make Cape Town Rooibos Red Gin, rooibos is added to the original gin's concentrate. It is left to stew for three hours (no longer, as rather than a warm amber, the colour goes all sorts of haywire) before being cut further with neutral spirit and brought back to bottling strength. To taste, there is a smoky tea flavour that whips its way around the tongue, holding all of the other botanicals in the gin hostage. The spice, though, is light and bright – catching in the back of the throat and burning all the way down. The tea infusion is to the star anise what E-numbers are to a five-year-old. The spice runs around like a lunatic, loud and fast, dizzy and silly. Serve with rosemary or cucumber.

Geometric R60

Riebeek-Kasteel

Geometric Gin is distilled from neutral spirits and fine grape spirit, resulting in a textured, silk-like gin. Fresh juniper is underpinned by citrus and cardamom, followed by heathery fynbos, our post-modern definition of Classic Cape Dry Gin. Serve with cardamom pods.

Flowstone Marula R60

Cradle of Humankind

Marula, the iconic fruit of Africa, has been enjoyed by man and elephants alike over the millennia. These majestic Bushveld trees produce an abundance of fruits in the African mid-summer months of January and February. The antics of elephants that have overindulged in fallen fermenting Marulas are legendary. (but not necessarily true!) Clear tangy edge with a rich, almost citrus flavour of the Marula fruit. Serve with a slice of lime & a sprinkling of Acacia blossoms.

Sugarbird Pino & Pelargonium R60

Cape Town

A floral gin inspired by the resurgence of traditional gin, their hope is to share a distinctively Cape Town made, crafted product with the world. Mastered with indigenous ingredients and creativity growing at the heart of the gin movement in

South Africa. The rich punch of colour from the Pinotage grape skins partnered with the fragrant floral flavours from Pelargonium set this rosy refreshment apart.

De Vry Rooinek Cherry R60

Free State

Eight botanicals are infused with vapour to deliver a crisp dry gin with lingering citrus, pepper and floral notes. Die Droë Rooinek Dry Gin owes its unmistakable taste to a combination of juniper, coriander, angelica, chamomile, khaki bos, pink peppercorn, lemon and orange. Cherry variety is made from handpicked and gently crushed cherries, which are then macerated in the dry gin before being filtered and bottled. Die Soet Rooinek Cherry Gin bursts with the flavour of ripe fruits, almonds and spices. Both spirits made from sorghum base.

Rawdons R60

Nottingham Road

Originally famous for their craft beers, this Midlands establishment now creates gin with redistilled juniper berries. Enjoy this gin with a sprig of rosemary.

Cape Fynbos R60

Cape Town

Quadruple distilled from the finest white grape spirits in small batches. This is then infused with premium juniper berries and elements from 33 indigenous botanicals, sustainably hand harvested for their bark, roots, berries, flowers, stems, peels or leaves. Most of these botanicals are members of the fynbos group of plants for which the region is world famous. Deep and complex herbal aromas with hints of orange essence, cloves and white pepper, honey and wild Fynbos all overlaying a perfectly smooth palate make this into a gin to treasure.

Die Mas R60

Kalahari

Kakamas boasts unique climatic conditions, where the waters of the powerful Orange River & the clear African skies bring to life the rich soil of this semi-desert region. Grapes grown & picked here are distilled to form a gin with rounded notes of juniper, delicate spiciness from traditional botanicals & a welcoming lemon & citrus finish.

Mothers Ruin R60

Produced in harmony with nature this purest wine spirit is made with water from the Franschhoek mountains & unique Fynbos botanicals, including buchu, honeybush, wild dagga & Devils Claw. It's a well balanced assortment of herbs, spices & zest on the nose, revealing juniper & fynbos on the palate. Sip neat or with soda & tonic mixer, together with fresh mint & lemon or fresh pineapple & curry leaves!

Red Stone R60

Clarens

Named after the red sandstone mountains surrounding Clarens. Originally, a brewery specializing in cider. Apples grown in the orchard, harvested, fermented into cider, is then distilled into Apple Schnapps. This is finally infused with botanicals & distilled one last time to produce a crystal clear refreshing botanical gin, with slight sweetness of fruit & berries.

Step 5 R60

Cape Town

Those familiar with Nataniel Currier's A Drunkard's Progress, basically a wino companion to the world famous Rake's Progress series, will quickly pick up on the allusion behind the odd title.
