Located out of the rush of the busy reserves where game drives & walks are frequented by large groups, we offer more intimate excursions here on Guernsey. Bush walks are early morning guided walk's (to avoid the heat of the day) All activities are with experienced & knowledgeable guides who offer the full 'bush experience' rather than ticking animals off the list and moving on to the next.

KRUGER PARK - VERY POPULAR

Enjoy a full day guided tour of the Kruger National Park. Experience the thrill of watching some of the world's largest animals in their natural habitat. An early collection from Kingfisher Creek will allow you to view the animals while they are most active. Experience the sights and smells of the bush from an open top safari vehicle. AFTERNOON BIG 5 GAME DRIVE

Enjoy a morning or afternoon drive on a reserve close to Hoedspruit (40 km from Kingfisher Creek) You can self-drive or choose a transfer (recommended) to the reserve. Enjoy a wide variety of game such as lion, cheetah, elephant,, leopard and general game. The safari drive takes 3 hours. Refreshment & light snacks are included.

MANYELETI GAME RESERVE- HALF DAY

Big 5

The Manyeleti Game reserve is a 23,000-hectare game reserve which borders the Kruger National Park. There are no fences between the Kruger and the Manyeleti so the game can roam freely, however, the volumes of people are significantly less here so you can enjoy a quieter game viewing experience. Morning Manyeleti drives depart at 5am, Afternoon Manyeleti drives depart at 2pm return you to the lodge in time for dinner. Don't forget your binoculars!

QUAD BIKE SAFARI

Join us for a 1.5hr Quad bike trail at Buffaloland, a Big 3 reserve. The track will take you through various landscapes with amazing views of the local plains and wildlife. Animals that can be observed on this journey include Buffalo, Leopards, Lions, Giraffes, Kudu, Wildebeest, Ostriches, Baboons, and an abundance of birdlife. Drivers need to be 16 yrs + for this trail. Passengers welcome up to 16 years.

PANORAMA ROUTE -FULL DAY

The Panorama route is home to the Blyde River canyon which is the third largest canyon in the world. After collection at Kingfisher Creek your tour begins at the spectacular 3 Rondawels, overlooking the canyon and from there, you slowly work your way along the various scenic beauty sights that encompass the Panorama route.

For those seeking adventure an additional stop can be requested in Graskop Gorge (ADDITIONAL COST) to experience The Viewing Lift & Forest Walk, The Big Swing, The Zipline or the suspension bridge.

BLYDE CANYON BOAT CRUISE

Blyde Canyon Safaris, offer scenic boat trips on the Blyde Dam. This is your opportunity to see the famous Three Rondawels and the Blyde River Canyon from the angle it's supposed to be seen: while you're on the water, at the base of the towering mountains that form these breath-taking sights. Tick off those last couple of birds that have been eluding your bird list and enjoy seeing the hippo's and crocodiles that make this dam their home. The boat tour is 1.5 hrs & trip times are: 9am, 11am, 1pm & 3pm

The Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre contributes to the conservation of endangered species and the rehabilitation of injured & poisoned wildlife. Animals to be seen are: Lion, Leopard, Hyena, Cheetah, Serval, Lynx, Honey Badger, Eagles, Vultures, Wild Dogs

Tours are twice daily Monday- Saturday NO SUNDAY : 09.30 & 15:00

SCENIC FLIGHT

Choose from a 30-minute game viewing flight on a Bantam and feel the wind in your hair or feel as free as a bird in a Jabiru and take a 30-minute flight over the Blyde River Canyon. Flights are operated in the mornings from Hoedspruit Civil airport in town and the maximum weight limit is 100kg for the Bantam and 120kg for the Jabiru. Flights are operated with 1 pilot and 1 passenger.

HELICOPTER FLIGHT OVER CANYON

Experience the largest Green Canyon in the world from the comfort of a 3 passenger helicopter.

The famous Three Rondawels, Belvedere Powerstation, Wild Mountain Horses and many waterfalls. Big 5 game are also often spotted.

Please note the Helicopter flights are weather dependant. Refunds are issued if a cancellation occurs due to weather. Passenger weights required when making an enquiry. Scenic Flights depart from Hoedspruit Civil Airfield (in the centre of Hoedspruit).

The rate is the same whether it is for 1 – 3 guests (making is very affordable if there are 3 guests splitting the cost)

GRASKOP GORGE

The The Graskop Gorge Lift Company is centrally located on the Panorama Route. Choose from

- The Lift : takes visitors 51m down the face of the gorge into the indigenous forest below
- Forest Walk - where a trail of elevated walkways and suspension bridges await.
- Suspension Bridge- Hold your breath & venture across the 52m suspension bridge 70m above the gorge.
- Zipline - gives you a birds eye view of the gorge.
- Big Swing-For our adrenaline seekers- Freefall 70m in under 3 seconds

COURSE INFO

Duration: 3 hours

Appropriate for children aged 6 – 15 years.

Our junior ranger course is an interactive and practical course, suitable for children from 6 upwards. The course

lasts approximately 3 hours and is led by experienced field guides. It is an exciting and fun introduction to understanding the South African bush.

Topics covered include:

ANIMAL TRACKING

We will take a short walk into the bush, identifying and following animal tracks.

ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION

Looking into the famous ‘Big 5’ and the many species of plains game and birds found on Guernsey Nature Reserve.

ANIMAL BEHAVIOUR

Learning how animals communicate and interact with one another as well as observing animals safely.

ANIMAL CALLS

Africa’s birds and animals have some of the world’s most distinctive calls. While out on our bush walk we will try to identify a few of these.

DUNG IDENTIFICATION

Investigate various types of animal dung discovering what the animal eats and find out which animal it belongs to.

INSECTS

Observe species such as termites, butterflies and some of the ‘Small 5’ such as the ‘Ant lion’ and ‘Rhinceros beetle’.

TREES AND PLANTS

Have you ever made your own toilet paper or toothbrush from a tree? Join us on the course to find out how!

BUSH NAVIGATION

How to find your way in the bush using the sun and natural indicators.

SMALL SURVIVAL SKILLS

How to find water and food in the bush as well as ‘bush medicine’.

MAKING A FIRE

Heading back to the boma to make a fire... the first one to create flames wins a prize!
