What you need to know:

Venue Hire- R45,000.00 (subject to full quotation)

Includes: staff to assist with set up and clean up, and certain furniture and décor items (please enquire for full list).

Excludes: Wedding/event planner, suppliers (photographer/videographer, audiovisual, hairstylist, and florist), additional lighting and sound, entertainment, and music.

Accommodation - Pafuri Camp can accommodate a total of 52 guests across 19 tents. This includes 7 family tents for up to four people each, 12 double tents for 2 people each. Additionally, Baobab Hill House provides 4 bedrooms, accommodating an extra 8 guests or suppliers. Pafuri Walking Safaris, available from April to October, feature 8 glamping tents that can sleep up to 16 people.

Food & Beverage - Pafuri can cater to various dietary requirements, including vegetarian, vegan, Halaal, kosher, banting, glut en-free, and lactose intolerant. While Pafuri strive to accommodate food preferences, certain items may not be locally available due to the remote location. A visit to Pafuri to discuss the menu with the head chef is highly recommended. Any modifications to the provided wedding menus will be discussed and quoted accordingly. The camp has a well-stocked bar, and should wine or champagne be brought in, a corkage fee of R150 is applied, limited to a maximum of one dozen (12) bottles.

Solar Power - The Pafuri Collection operate primarily on a self-sustaining solar farm, emphasising their commitment to eco-friendliness. To maintain this eco-conscious approach, guests are kindly requested to avoid using heat-generating appliances like hair dryers, curling irons, and straighteners. however, the camp acknowledges the importance of the bridal party looking their best and offers to activate backup generators at a specified time provided by the guests.

Lighting - You are welcome to bring additional lighting to enhance your event; however, it is required that the lights are either LED and compatible with the camp's electrical systems or battery-operated. Please chat to us beforehand to avoid disappointment.
