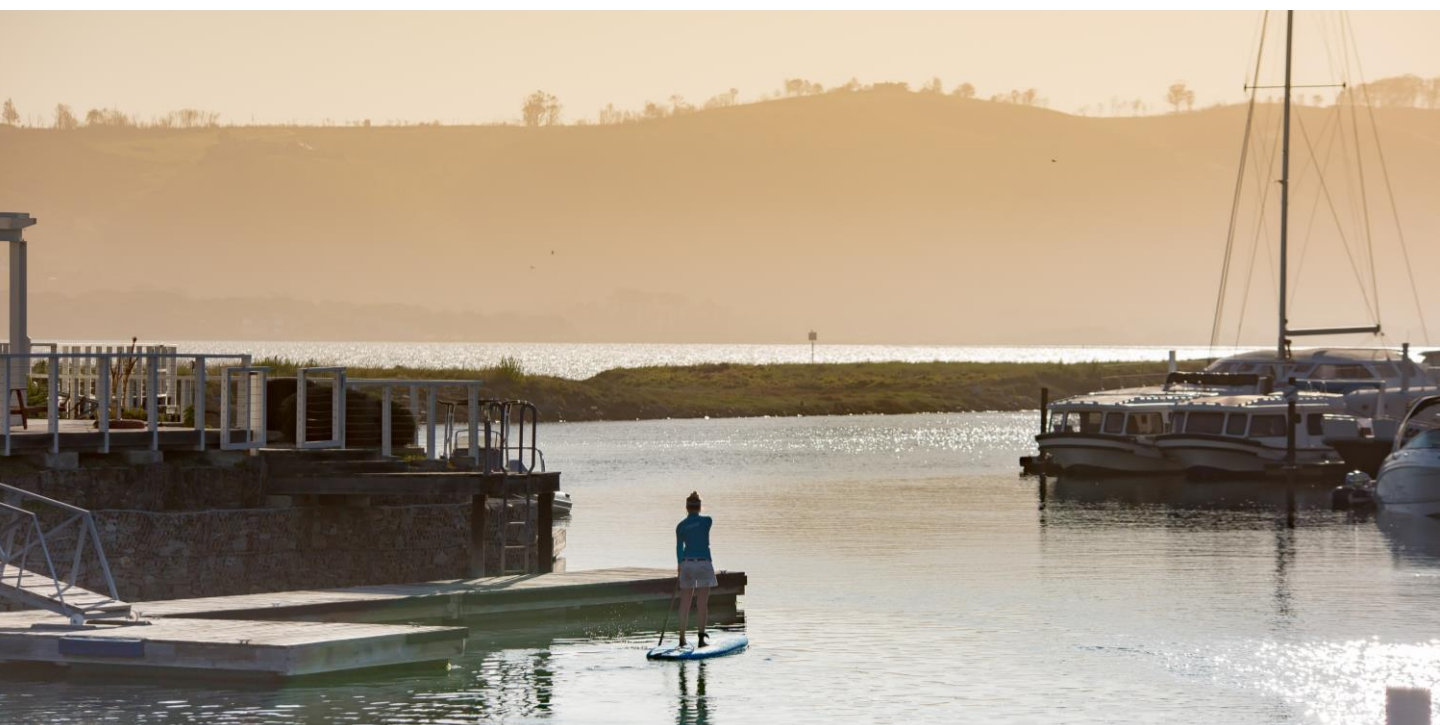

WHAT TO BRING

Be prepared to get wet

Make sure you bring a towel, swimming attire and dry clothes as there is a good chance you may end up in the water

Cell phones, Cameras, Go Pro's

Guests are welcome to take along cell phones, cameras and/or Go Pros, but they must ensure that they have a watertight/waterproof pouch/bag/cover for these items.

Sunscreen and Sunglasses

On sunny days you can get quite a sunburn and sunglasses will help protect your eyes from glare off the water as you scan the horizon.

SAFETY

The safety of our guests and crew are our number one priority all individuals participating in the activity must wear their life jacket at all times.

Beginners are encouraged to remain in the Thesen Island canals where the boat traffic and wakes are minimal. Experienced paddlers can proceed into the estuary at their own risk

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Stand Up Paddling is best suited for windless days on the estuary. Strong winds can make the activity difficult for individuals.
