Comfortably spacious interiors and furnishings strike the perfect balance between luxury and functionality, while sprawling decks stretch into nature, offering unhindered views of the vast plains of the Serengeti, Zimbabwe's rugged sandstone ridges, Rwanda's majestic mountains and the lush riverine forests of Sabi Sand – to name but a few.

The Singita Private Villa Collection gives guests the relaxed freedom to tailor-make their days any way they want, and with a full private staff complement dedicated to their every need, mealtimes and activities can be personalised at every turn. Each villa includes a private host, chef, housekeepers and butlers, as well as private safari vehicles and Field Guide. Leisure facilities range from tennis courts to private massage treatment rooms, cinemas, media rooms, fitness centers and expansive swimming pools.

Singita Kataza House, Rwanda

ACCOMMODATION

In response to its unique natural setting, Singita Kataza House features two heated plunge pools, in-and outdoor fireplaces and large timber-framed windows that welcome the breathtaking scenery inside, ensuring an unrivalled guest experience surrounded by Rwanda's rainforests and awe-inspiring Virunga Mountain range.

Accommodating up to 8 guests, the villa comprises two spacious suites, a junior master suite and a lavish master suite with its own heated pool. A central cluster of inviting living areas spill out into extensive outdoor spaces. The home also includes a two-bedroom staff residence, wine cellar, fitness centre, cinema, massage treatment room, interactive kitchen and fire pit, as well as a full staff complement and mouthwatering farm-to-table food journey with fresh produce from the onsite Akarabo Garden.

ACTIVITIES

Set right on the edge of Volcanoes National Park, Kataza House puts gorilla-trekking experiences within easy reach and the villa is located less than ten minutes from the Park's headquarters. This inimitable location also allows for chimpanzee and golden monkey trekking, various hiking excursions, mountain biking and cultural visits. In-room wellness treatments and garden and nursery tours enhance this deeply restorative experience. All the facilities and amenities at the adjacent Singita Kwitonda Lodge are at guests' disposal, providing the convenience of a hotel without any infringement on solitude.

Singita Lebombo Villa, South Africa

Ensnconced under shady trees and set on the picturesque banks of the N'wanetsi River in Singita Kruger National Park, this light and airy villa is surrounded by a rich and diverse habitat teeming with iconic wildlife. Accommodating up to 8 guests, it comprises two 2-bedroom suites – each with its own private pool – which link together to create a magnificent 4-bedroom offering.

Providing friends or families with a contemporary retreat in the heart of this iconic wilderness in the South African bush, this sophisticated villa includes a private boma, open-plan kitchen and airy living areas that flow onto welcoming outdoor spaces with an expansive pool.

Inviting unlimited opportunities to reconnect and experience a sense of togetherness in this pristine natural setting, guests can spend their days unwinding poolside, enjoying soothing wellness treatments, yoga and meditation, and relishing world-class wine tastings. Singita Castleton, South Africa

ACCOMMODATION

Reminiscent of an African farmhouse, Singita Castleton welcomes friends and families home to unmatched exclusivity and comfort in the heart of the bush. This former residence of the grandfather of Singita's Founder, Luke Bailes, features relaxed and understated interiors imbued with nostalgic references that capture Castleton's original history and spirit.

Six double en-suite guest cottages spill onto tree-shaded lawns and the main homestead includes beautifully light & inviting communal spaces. Boasting many refashioned antiques and furnishings from the original house, it also offers deep, covered verandas overlooking the busy waterhole nearby, where game regularly gather to drink.

ACTIVITIES

Set within 45,000 acres of pristine wilderness, Castleton offers exceptional game viewing opportunities and guided bush walks, as well as magical fireside dinners under starlit skies in the private outdoor boma. An expansive swimming pool, tennis court, yoga pavilion, boules court, fitness centre and double and single massage treatment rooms ensure complete relaxation.

Singita Ebony Villa, South Africa

ACCOMMODATION

Nestled on the banks of the Sand River in the heart of South Africa's 'Big Cat' country, this idyllic family retreat provides the ideal location to restore and celebrate cherished connections with loved ones.

Evoking the romance and adventure of tented safaris with stylish canvas details and expansive glass doors and windows, the villa's two secluded family suites are set alongside each other, making it perfect for adults with small children or teenagers. Wrapped around its inimitable vantage point overlooking the breathtaking Malilangwe Dam, this expansive African home features five vast guest suites – each with its own private deck – an interactive kitchen and an expansive rim-flow pool, ensuring an easy-going flow and encouraging a seamless interplay between restorative solitude and precious time together.

Singita Explore, Tanzania

Designed for private use, the camp accommodates a maximum of six tented suites catering for families or friends, and is pitched and set up in the Serengeti's most exquisite hidden locations, based on the requirements of each booking.

Campaign-style furniture and durable canvas, leather and chrome elements echo the textures and tones of the natural surrounds. Waking up to birdsong in the heart of the wilderness, your days unfold to the pace of nature, concluding under a canopy of stars around the campfire at night.

The villa provides the ultimate laidback luxury in the wilderness with a 25-metre lap pool, tennis court, fire pit, media room, fitness centre and massage treatment sala – coupled with the easy elegance of comfortable interiors, a modern eat-in kitchen and four boldly proportioned suites with outdoor showers and private terraces.

Providing the utmost seclusion and comfort, this expansive standalone property offers everything from private wellness treatments to stargazing, wine tastings and cooking classes, with hot-air ballooning and tailor-made game drives, bush walks and community experiences allowing for a fully immersive stay.

At Singita Grumeti in Tanzania, guests will find Explore and Serengeti House; and just a short flight away, in Rwanda, Singita Kataza House is nestled on the edge of Volcanoes National Park.

South Africa

Spanning more than 45,000 acres, Singita Sabi Sand is renowned for high concentrations of big game and frequent leopard sightings. Here, you'll find Singita Ebony Villa and Castleton.

Singita Lebombo Villa is situated in a 33,000 acre private concession of isolated wilderness in the Kruger National Park, where a unique wildlife population thrives across four direct ecological areas.

Zimbabwe

A pristine stretch of Zimbabwe spanning 130,000 acres, the Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve, is home to Singita Malilangwe House.

Tanzania

Singita Explore and Serengeti House are both located in Singita Grumeti. Situated adjacent to the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania, it's an integral part of the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem, the home of the Great Migration.

Rwanda

Singita Kataza House is located on a breathtaking 178-acre piece of land right on the edge of Volcanoes National Park in Rwanda.
