

Africa House (newly refurbished in 2023) is Malewane Lodge's exclusive-use private villa - perfect for families or groups of friends travelling together.







The Waters of Royal Malewane Bush Spa at Malewane Lodge invokes the therapeutic properties of water. Treatments make use of mineral-rich water sourced from an underground stream that flows through the reserve. Positioned around the central courtyard with its 25m (82ft) heated lap pool, you will find three treatment rooms (1x double and 2x single), as well as a fully equipped gym, a steam room, hot and cold African baths, hair salon and four casitas.


