**JANUARY**

The end of the short rains and temps can be rather high during the day. Tarangire's rugged landscape is lush and green and this is a great time for birders to visit. Plains game is dispersed around the park.

❄️ 16°C / 61°F ☀️ 29°C / 84°F ☁️ 79mm / 3.1in

**FEBRUARY**

Temperature remains high in February, but the landscape should still be green. We would expect even more of the 550 species of bird living in or migrating to Tarangire to be spotted so another great month for birders or those looking to escape the crowds.

**MARCH**

March brings the start of the long rains and towards the end of the month, we would expect cloudy skies and showers most days. The fantastic birding opportunities continue and there are great low season rates at Oliver's.

**APRIL**

Long rains - camp closed

❄️ 17°C / 63°F ☀️ 27°C / 81°F ☁️ 166mm / 6.5in

**MAY**

Long rains - camp opens from the 16th

❄️ 16°C / 61°F ☀️ 25°C / 77°F ☁️ 57mm / 2.2in

**JUNE**

The temperatures continue to cool as we move into the dry season. The plains game can still be dispersed in June and grasses could still be tall so driving safaris at this time of year are preferable to walking safaris. Keep an eye open for the blooming wildflowers in June.

❄️ 14°C / 57°F ☀️ 25°C / 77°F ☁️ 5mm / 0.2in

**JULY**

For those looking to enjoy a walking safari or an overnight fly camp, now is an excellent time. The long grasses have been grazed, temperatures are cool and the clear, calm skies make for excellent conditions. The plains game is becoming more abundant

❄️ 13°C / 55°F ☀️ 24°C / 75°F ☁️ 13mm / 0.5in

**AUGUST**

Dry season is in full swing and now is a great time to see the large herds of elephants for which Tarangire is famous. Daytime temperatures are comfortable but warm clothing is still needed for those early morning drives as the air will be chilly.

❄️ 13°C / 55°F ☀️ 25°C / 77°F

**SEPTEMBER**

During these dry months, Tarangire has a fantastic concentration of mammals. And with the vegetation being thinned out there are outstanding game viewing opportunities to enjoy.

❄️ 14°C / 57°F ☀️ 27°C / 81°F ☁️ 4mm / 0.2in

**OCTOBER**

Temperatures start to creep back up, but it is still dry with good concentrations of plains game and predators. Game viewing in October is particularly good around the permanent water sources like Silale swamps and the Tarangire River.

❄️ 15°C / 59°F ☀️ 29°C / 84°F ☁️ 14mm / 0.6in

**NOVEMBER**

With the short rains starting mid-month, most days will have showers in the afternoons, a welcome reprieve from the warmer temperatures. These short rains rarely impact daily safari excursions, so November is a great time to take advantage of lower season rates and a less busy park.

❄️ 16°C / 61°F ☀️ 29°C / 84°F ☁️ 71mm / 2.8in

**DECEMBER**

The short rains continue, and temperatures remain high. The plains game begins to disperse a little, but the migratory birds start to arrive. (As do the holiday crowds – remember to book early for availability over the festive season).

❄️ 17°C / 63°F ☀️ 29°C / 84°F ☁️ 110mm / 4.3in
