



DAY Njoro trek

Walk description:

Departure from Olduvai Camp with Maasai guides

As a start, gradual descent to the Gorges, walking through trees and Oldupai. One can see some dik-dik, giraffes, hares, even high concentration of wildebeest & zebras during migration season.

Descent into the gorge itself, even if walls aren't very high at this point. The access is easy and encounters with animals are rare. However it is common to meet Maasai fetching water in homemade water holes. And, depending on the season, lard herds of cattle coming down the gorge in search of water.

Progressively widening, the path goes up to the camp, passing by shrubands area and grass plains. Once again, one can meet some Maasai with their cattle.

<u>**Duration**</u>: About 1h30 / 2h00. Early morning departure (7:00 to 9:00AM and back for breakfast)

Level: Easy. Good shoes are required. Walk suitable for children
