## **Table Mountain, Penguins & Cape Point - From Cape Town**

Small Group Tour: Save time, avoid crowds, and see the highlights of the Cape Town area in a single day on this small-group tour. Admire the colorful houses of Bo Kaap, ride a cable car up and down Table Mountain, embark on a scenic drive along Chapman's Peak, and visit the penguin colony of Boulder's Beach.

## **Guided Day Tour to Cape Point, Penguins and Wine Tasting**

Focus on the scenery and your experience of Cape Point on this multi-stop tour with all transportation included. With a small group of just seven people or fewer, visit some of the highlights of the Cape Point area, including the Cape Peninsula, Camps Bay Beach, Hout Bay, Chapman's Peak Drive, the Cape of Good Hope, and the penguins at Boulders Beach. Instead of fussing over directions and navigation, simply sit back and enjoy the epic scenery as you travel on Boyes Drive, False Bay, and Shark Spotters lookout. The day's last stop is Constantia Valley for a wine tasting session to unwind before returning to Cape Town.

## **Cape Point Sightseeing Tour**

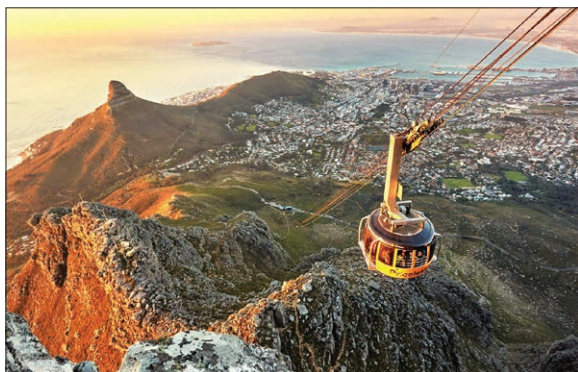
Enjoy a beautiful drive to Cape Point from Cape Town on a half-day tour. The scenic route of Chapman's Peak Road takes you along the water past Hout Bay Harbour and Boulders Beach, with its resident African penguins, to Cape Point. It's part of Table Mountain National Park, and there are spectacular views from the Cape of Good Hope.

## **Cape Peninsula Tour - From Cape Town**

Experience the scenic beauty and natural landscapes of South Africa's Cape Peninsula on this full-day tour from Cape Town. Enjoy the convenience of guided visits, as well as the independence of solo sightseeing and learn about this dynamic region from your friendly, knowledgeable guide. See seals in Hout Bay (with optional Duiker Island boat trip) and have time to wander the shops. You can explore the Cape Point Nature Reserve at your leisure, and check out playful families of African penguins in Simon's Town. Your return trip to Cape Town even includes a stop at the colorful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.

## **Cape Peninsula Guided Private Day Trip - From Cape Town**

With spectacular coastal scenery and world-famous natural features, the Cape Peninsula ranks among the most beautiful corners of South Africa. 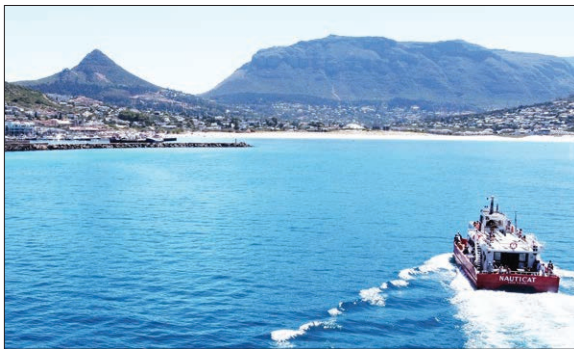

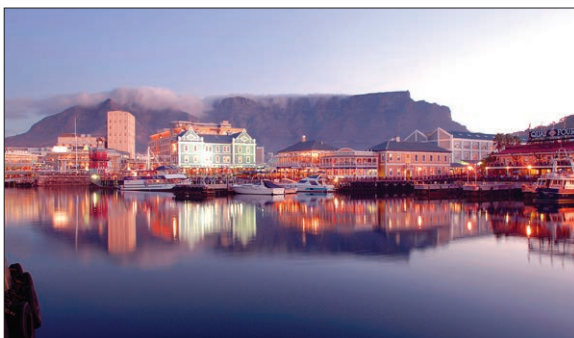
## Nauticat Charters - Hout Bay

Enjoy a slow cruise to Duiker Island and experience the playful seals, the beautiful bird life and the wonderful landscapes of the area. One has an incredible view of Chapman's Peak, The Sentinel and Hout Bay from the boat. The cruise departs from Hout Bay Harbour and is a 60 min trip.



## Robben Island Tour and Museum

Trace the footsteps of South Africa's Gallant Freedom Fighters at the Robben Island Museum. The museum is located on Robben Island, just off the coast of Cape Town. It holds a significant place in South African history as it once housed the country's most famous political prisoner and freedom fighter, Nelson Mandela. It is now a World Heritage Site and one of the most popular tourist attractions in South Africa.



## V&A Waterfront

The V&A Waterfront is a 123-hectare area which caters to both local and international visitors. Offering everything from hotels, retail shop, extensive dining, leisure and entertainment. Its many heritage sites and tourism landmarks make it both exceptional and unique, as does the recently opened Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa (MOCAA), which hosts the world's largest collection of contemporary art from Africa.
