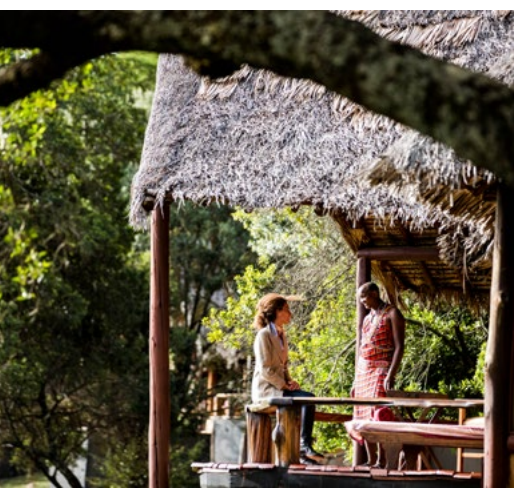
VIEW OVER THE VALLEY & MARA NORTH CONSERVANCY

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

Saruni Basecamp believes fully and invests significantly in community development and conservation.

More than 80% of Saruni Mara’s employees are Maasai from the local communities. They are trained and employed so that the local communities benefit directly from the lodge being in their area.

- Saruni Mara has formed a local women’s group, where the ladies are encouraged to sell their artifacts through the Saruni shop.
- Saruni Basecamp sponsors young Maasai to train as guides at the Koiyaki Guiding School, and lead future generations of conservationists and safari guides.
- The lodge protects the northern corridors of the Masai Mara ecosystem and contributes to the preservation of the Lemek and Mara North Conservancies.
