Freedom and safety, adventure and contemplation - our mountains on the western edge of the Mara are the final destination of the annual great migration between July and October, where millions of animals add to the already existing resident herds.






The cottages are furnished with flushing eco-toilets alongside beautifully crafted basins and showers with running hot and cold water. Colonial antiques, Persian carpets and African art decorate the rooms with double and twin beds. The verandah is comfortably equipped with a sunbed and hammock where one can look out into the plains and enjoy the incredible shows put on by elephants, waterbuck, buffalo and rare bird species.

After a full day exploring the African wild, or enjoying the tranquility of Saruni's library set in a quiet corner in front of a water hole where animals visit, Kuro House invites you to bitings and drinks around the fireplace as you take in the calls of the pocturnal animals.

Gourmet cuisine follows at the main table or in the privacy of your cottage.











