Officially declared UNESCO's 1 oooth World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa, the Okavango Delta is undeniably Botswana's crown jewel.

AN UNEXPECTED WONDER The broad Okavango River, which emanates from the Angolan highlands, sinks into the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert, creating a lush and waterlogged oasis. Known as the river that never finds the sea, the result of this is the most unexpected wonder – water present in a desert.

A WATERY WILDERNESS

A variety of incredible water experiences is on offer in the Delta. Glide through a maze of clear channels and opaque lagoons on a traditionally made mokoro (dugout canoe), silently passing by unsuspecting wildlife, or cover a greater distance on a motorised boat. Sparkling channels teem with fish, while birds and frogs inhabit the reeded banks.

ICONIC WILDLIFE SIGHTINGS

The Okavango Delta is home to a large number of species, including some that are specially adapted to the semi-aquatic lifestyle, like the elegant red lechwe and shy sitatunga antelope. Hippo are found in lagoons, while cheetah, leopard and African wild dog share the floodplains with elephant and buffalo.



In collaboration with Africa Foundation, our long-standing community and conservation development partner.



CARE OF The Land

- 155 856 plastic water bottles eliminated per year in Botswana as a result of on-site lodge bottling plants
- 2 670 tons of concrete removed from the Okavango Delta
- Hybrid solar power plant systems in operation at our Botswana lodges have the capacity to supply up to 80% of the lodges' energy requirements.
- Our Sandibe solar power plant (installed in 2014) was the first of its kind in Botswana, and the second on the African continent
- Nxabega and Xaranna lodges utilise the cutting edge Tesla Powerpack system
- All our Botswana lodges have sophisticated, environment-friendly above-ground wastewater treatment systems
- Progressive reduction of our direct carbon footprint through a system of Group goals, measured by annual lodge audits

care of The Wildlife

- Long-term support of the WildCRU Trans-Kalahari Predator Programme, based out of the University of Oxford, which aims to identify and protect wildlife corridors in Botswana
- Support of the Botswana Predator Conservation Trust with their African Wild Dog Dispersal Study – a project that is fundamental to the management and conservation of this endangered species
- Rhinos Without Borders a collaboration between &Beyond and Great Plains Conservation – has translocated 93 rhino from South Africa to Botswana, with the new source population now numbering well over the target of 100. The significant number of calves born is testimony to the success of this conservation initiative.

- 94% of our staff complement are local Botswana citizens; an average of over 100 training interventions annually

Within the Delta, water levels change yearly. Enjoy these seasonal experiences at Nxabega Okavango Tented Camp and Xaranna Okavango Delta Camp.

Pastel-coloured lilies float upon verdant lily pads, butterflies captivate with their iridescent wings and tiny painted frogs cling to the reeds as you take to the tranquil waterways in a traditional mokoro (dugout canoe). Keep a careful look out for the variety of fish darting through the crystal-clear water below you.

CATCH-AND-RELEASE FISHING
