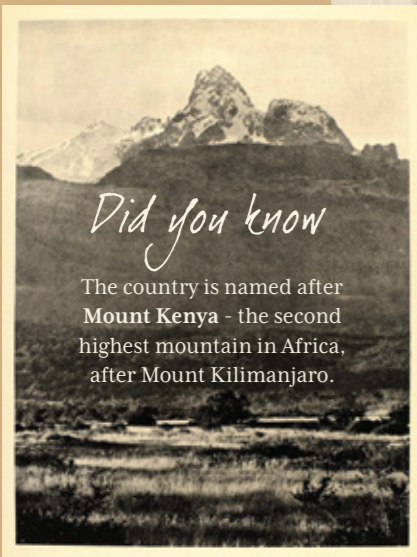

ABOUT KENYA

Kenya's territory lies on the equator and overlies the East African Rift, covering a diverse and expansive terrain. It is bordered by Tanzania to the south and south-west, Uganda to the west, South Sudan to the north-west, Ethiopia to the north, Somalia to the north-east, and the Indian Ocean to the east. At 580,367 km² (224,081 sq mi), Kenya is the world's forty-seventh largest country and is similar in size to the State of Texas.

WHY CHOOSE KENYA

Thanks to its diverse climate and geography, expansive wildlife reserves and national parks such as the massive East and West Tsavo National Parks, Amboseli National Park, Masai Mara Reserve, Lake Nakuru National Park, Aberdares National Park and the pristine white sand beaches of Diani, Mombasa and Watamu, Kenya is classed as one of the premiere safari destinations in the world. World heritage sites including the Old Town of Lamu Island and Fort Jesus on Mombasa island add to this unique and varied destination.

The country is named after Mount Kenya - the second highest mountain in Africa, after Mount Kilimanjaro.
