Working through our social development partner, the Ubunye Foundation, we invest in projects that improve lives and create sustainable livelihoods opportunities in marginalised rural communities.

Over the past 17 years, we have, in partnership with the Ubunye Foundation, made a real difference in the Eastern Cape with the following projects:

- o Adult education and training, leading to positions within our game reserve team
- o A dedicated Wellness Programme for Kwandwe team members and their families
- o The construction of Fort Brown Primary School
- o Co-funding of the Development Centre for Rhodes University
- o Land donation to the development of an agri-village and Community Centre for the region
- o A pre-school and aftercare centre on the reserve for our team's children
- o Housing and services for over 400 people in our team and community

Every guest staying at Kwandwe Private Game Reserve makes a direct contribution to community development through the Conservation and Community Levy (funds raised from this levy are split between these two initiatives). When you visit Kwandwe, your stay supports the direct employment of over 200 people who work and live on the property with their families.
