- **NO COLLECTING OF FIREWOOD**
- **NO FIRES except in braai facilities**
- **COVER UNATTENDED FIRES**
- **NO LITTERING**
- **NO PETS**
- **NO NOISE, LOUD MUSIC, ETC**
- **NO FIREWORKS**
- **NO DRONES**
- **NO ACCESS TO GREEN BELT between 22:00 & 05:00**

Failure to follow these rules will result in action being taken against visitors, this may include fines and/or eviction from the Estate.
