

WHY VISIT?

Timbavati



The Timbavati Private Game Reserve borders the Kruger National Park to the north and east. The name Timbavati was derived from a Shangaan expression meaning 'the place where something sacred came down to earth from the heavens'.

The Timbavati has a vast array of wildlife, which includes the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino) thriving amongst giraffe, zebra, warthogs, hyena and many antelope species. This sums up the magical spirit of the Timbavati, which has a tangible sense of wilderness.

The reserve is also a protective habitat for sustainable populations of many endangered species such as black and white rhinoceros, pangolins, and many others.

In-Room Facilities &



- Private viewing deck
- Chalet bathroom comprises a bath, double vanity with indoor shower
- Tent bathroom features a double vanity, indoor and outdoor shower
- Complimentary eco-friendly amenities
- Minibar
- Coffee and tea-making facilities
- Air-conditioning
- Electric blankets (winter)
- Mini safe for storing valuables
- Hair dryer
- Laundry bag in room
- Room equipped with electronic eco-friendly insect spray (subtly sprayed at 10 minute intervals)



- Early morning tea/coffee
- Game drive (approximately 3 hours)
- Mid-morning breakfast on the dining deck
- Time to relax, enjoy a spa treatment or burn calories in the fitness center, cool down in the pool or spend some time on the deck overlooking the river bed and waterhole
- Afternoon tea
- Afternoon/evening game drive (approximately 3 hours)
- Dinner on the deck, or around the fire in the open-air boma (weather permitting)












Lodge Layout

GETTING THERE

Travel Options

Simbavati River Lodge is ±1 hour from Hoedspruit Eastgate Airport, and can be accessed by car.

The drive from Johannesburg is ±6.5 to 7 hours (505km), ±3.5 hours (210km) from Kruger Airport, and 3 hours (160km via the R40) from Hazyview.
