Little Sable is located in the Khwai Private Reserve, a 200,000-hectare area of pristine wilderness in the Greater Okavango. The reserve is bordered by Moremi to the south, Savuti to the north and the Khwai Community Reserve to the east – in other words, in the middle of some of the most famous and iconic game-viewing areas on the continent!

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

The Little Sable is open year-round with excellent game viewing throughout the seasons. Water levels are highest in April to October for exploring on mokoros and boats. At other times of year, water activities may be restricted. Dry season: April – October Green season: November – March Please see our rates sheet for detailed information on seasons & pricing.

HOW DO I GET THERE

Fly to Maun (direct flights are available from Cape Town and Johannesburg) and switch to a light aircraft to fly to our airstrip in the Khwai Private Reserve. Road transfers from Maun and self-drive options are also available – please contact us for details.

WHERE WILL I STAY

Little Sable has 8 twin/double rooms, all of which are tented and raised on wooden platforms to maximise the views across the grasslands. Each also has a ceiling fan and ensuite bathroom with with indoor and outdoor showers, and a private veranda.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature, personal travel insurance and transfers to the Skybeds (at a pp rate) are all excluded.

WHAT WILL I EAT

Our wonderful chefs have a reputation for their hearty, wholesome meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements before arrival.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The sunken lounge and fire pit is at the heart of camp and the perfect spot for a morning coffee or an evening sundowner. There is also a swimming pool, lounge, bar and dining area, all with spectacular views across the reserve.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children aged 6 years and older.
- There is Wi-Fi for guests in the main area.
- Charging facilities available in the rooms and at the main area.
- Each tent has an electronic safe.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 16 guests in camp.

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WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

Year Round:

- Morning & afternoon game drives.
- Mokoro safaris. (Water-level dependent).
- Visit our underground hides on request, by helicopter.*
- Helicopter flights over the Okavango Delta.*
- Fishing: 01 Mar 31 Dec. (No fishing permitted Jan Feb due to breeding season).
- Be part of the KPR Ranger Experience and spend time tracking predators, capturing data, patrolling and if time allows, visiting conservation projects.* (Proceeds of this are allocated to conservation efforts in KPR).
- *At an additional cost.

Dry Season:

- Boating safaris. (Water-level dependent).
- Sleep out under the stars at Skybeds. (Must be pre-booked, open 1 April - 31 October).

Children 16 years & older are welcome at Skybeds. If exclusive use is booked, then children between 12 - 15 years may participate, sharing a platform with an adult.

Children 6 years & older may take part in a mokoro or boat safari and participate in the Ranger Experience.

Children under 12 must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.
