After a stop in Namibia's lively capital, Windhoek, enjoy a stay in Sossusvlei, a stunning pan in the Namib Desert, and visit a cheetah conservation project. Overnight in the game-rich Etosha before arriving in the deepwater harbour of Walvis Bay.

AFRICAN TRILOGY

This panoramic sojourn winds its way from the Indian Ocean in the east to the Atlantic coast in the west. Starting in Pretoria, descend the spectacular escarpment to the Kruger for a game drive. Explore the Kingdom of eSwatini followed by a game drive in Hluhluwe and a tour of Durban. Traverse the imposing Drakensberg Mountains to visit the 1870s mining village of Kimberley. Continue through the Karoo semi-desert to Upington and the Fish River Canyon. See the Kalahari's Quiver trees before taking a short flight to Sossusvlei for a lodge stay surrounded by dramatic dunes. Visit Namibia's capital, Windhoek, and a cheetah conservation project before overnighing in the game-rich Etosha Park. Leave the vast stillness of the Namib for the wild Atlantic coast and journey's end, Walvis Bay.

- Take a short flight to **Sossusvlei** for a **lodge stay**, drive, bush dinner and breakfast near **Deadvlei** and **Star Dune 45**.
- Visit **Windhoek's** transport museum and a **cheetah conservation project**.
- Enjoy **game drives** and overnight at a lodge in **Etosha National Park**.
- Cross the **Namib Desert**, maybe the oldest desert in the world, to **Walvis Bay**.

DAR ES SALAAM JOURNEY

This epic expedition is one of the most famous train journeys in the world. From Cape Town, traverse the Karoo with visits to the historic village of Matjiesfontein, Kimberley's Diamond Mine Museum and the extraordinary Big Hole. Tour the capital city of Pretoria and enjoy the Big Five at Madikwe. Explore one of the natural wonders of the world, the Victoria Falls, before crossing the mighty Zambezi into Zambia for a bush walk at Chisimba Falls. Descend into the Rift Valley and witness spectacular scenery as the train negotiates the tunnels, switchbacks and viaducts of the escarpment. Pass the Selous – the largest reserve on the continent and a vision of timeless Africa – shortly before the bustling arrival in Dar es Salaam.

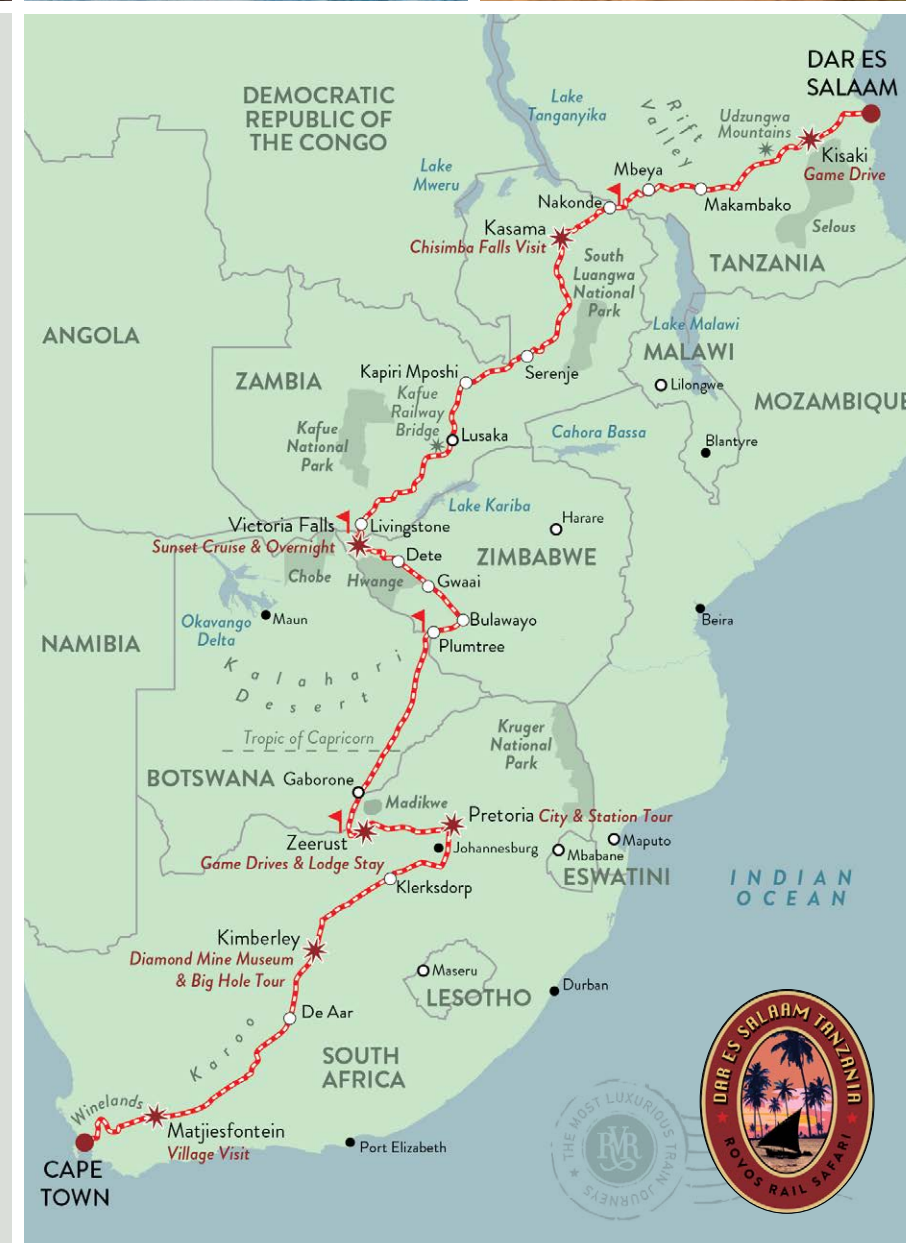

COPPER TRAIL

A novel 15-day expedition traversing Zimbabwe, Zambia, the DRC and Angola. Travel across the mighty Zambezi from the incomparable Victoria Falls towards Kafue River for a sunset cruise. After a visit to Lusaka's elephant sanctuary where teams rehabilitate orphaned elephants, fly into South Luangwa (Zambia) for a three-night safari. With its western and northwestern edge bounded by the Muchinga Escarpment, and the southern border lined with the Luangwa River, there is no shortage of dramatic topography in this beautiful game-rich park. Enjoy a tour of Lubumbashi (DRC) then join the historical copper trail for short walking tours detailing Angola's recent history with journey's end in Lobito.

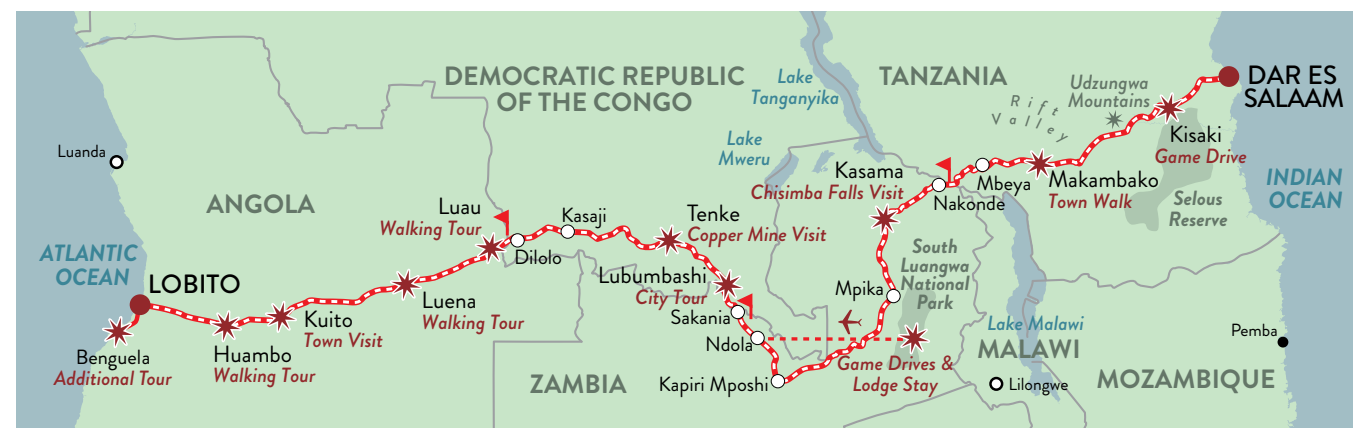

From our headquarters in Pretoria, successful charters from one to 10 days have been undertaken with incentive groups, historical expeditions, cycling tours, bird shoots and private family gatherings. There are many configurations combining our 42- or 72-bed train with other entertaining products and we are happy to construct exciting and practical itineraries to suit. Within reason, and subject to availability, the chartered train can go wherever there is a railway line in Southern Africa. The Events Train can accommodate up to 250 guests and is an ideal venue for weddings, launches, conferences and private functions.

THE EVENTS TRAIN

- Perfect venue for **private functions, launches** and **wedding** couples looking for something old-world and romantic.
- Take a **three-hour circular trip** around Pretoria or a **one-way journey** to any destination **within eight hours'** rail travel time from Pretoria (no overnight journeys).
- Depending on the number of guests, the train can host, with full bar facilities: a four-course sit-down lunch/dinner for **up to 120 guests** OR for **up to 250 guests**, hot snacks, canapés and cocktails.
- Dinner runs are popular and fine-dining, elegant affairs. **Example:** Guests are greeted at our private station by a sparkling wine reception; musicians play light classical music; our steam locomotive idles on the platform; time for intros and photos; time for speeches while the loco collects the coaches; depart for a circular tour of Pretoria; drinks served in the bar cars; dinner is presented in the opulent dining cars; return to the station.

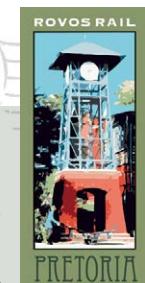


ROVOS RAIL STATION

A highlight of any trip is a visit to Rovos Rail's private station in Pretoria. Serving as the departure or arrival point for most of the journeys, this is the busy hub of a provisioning operation that is world-class in terms of efficiency and attention to detail. The 60-acre property boasts a small railway museum in addition to its other comprehensive facilities and will, with the addition of semaphore signals and a footbridge, recreate the atmosphere of a fully fledged railway system.

HOME & HEADQUARTERS

Rail enthusiasts will be drawn to the vast carriage and loco sheds where teams of dedicated personnel keep the rolling stock in order. This 10 000m² roofed workshop straddles 15 railway lines with concrete inspection pits below and is the ultimate repair and maintenance facility for any train operation. The low, red-bricked buildings alongside the 300m platform house laundries, gleaming stainless-steel kitchens and well-stocked storerooms.

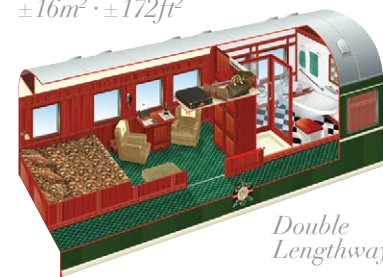

THE SUITES & COACHES

Each train has accommodation carriages, dining cars, a lounge car (±26 seats), small gift shop, smoking lounge (±11 seats) and observation car (±32 seats) with open-air balcony. The three types of suites are elegant and spacious offering passengers privacy, comfort and luxury with double or twin beds and fittings and facilities that are of the highest standard. All have en-suites with shower, toilet, basin and bath (Royal only), tea facilities, safes, air conditioning, linen and amenities and are serviced daily. There is adequate storage and small cupboards with hangers and shelves.

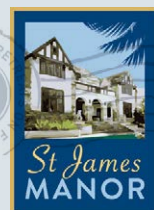

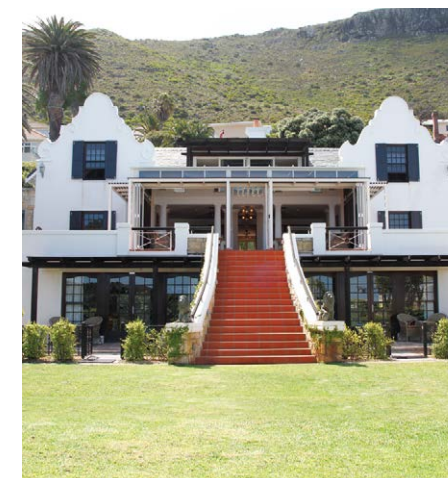
