WHERE IS SAFARI HOUSE

Safari House is just to the northeast of Safarihoek Lodge in the heart of the 600 square-kilometre Etosha Heights Private Reserve. Elusive mountain zebra, kudu and lion hide in the dolomite hills, and the waterholes attract large numbers of antelope and elephant. The Etosha area is famous for rhino sightings, and the reserve is home to both white and black rhino.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Safari House is open all year round and in this part of Africa, rainfall is scarce, even in the green season months.

Green Season: 10 January - 31 March

Shoulder Season: 01 April - 30 June & 01 November - 09 January

High Season: 01 July - 30 September & 20 December - 19 December

Peak Season: 01 August - 31 August & 01 October - 31 October

HOW DO I GET THERE

Fly to Windhoek (there are direct flights to Windhoek from Cape Town, Johannesburg, Frankfurt, Addis Ababa and Doha) and switch to a light aircraft to fly to our airstrip in the reserve. You may also self-drive to Safari House: 470 km from Windhoek, 150km from Outjo and 97km from Kamanjab. Please note that the roads are not suitable for sedan cars

WHERE WILL I STAY

Safari House is a private farmhouse with 3 ensuite bedrooms. Each room is air-conditioned with a private, sliding door entrance, and two have an inter-leading door that can be opened for families.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

All meals, daily activities, local drinks, and laundry services are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT WILL I EAT

Safari House has a fully-equipped kitchen and braai facilities and the private chef will whip up wholesome and hearty meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

Safari House has a fully-equipped kitchen, an indoor dining and sitting area, an outdoor veranda, braai facilities and a swimming pool. The garden is fully-fenced and the house comes with a private chef, guide and vehicle. Guests may also use the facilities at Safarihoek Lodge (swimming pool & curio shop) and dine at the lodge (with prior notice).

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children of all ages. (Please refer to our rates for child policies).
- The house is run entirely on solar power with a generator for back up.
- Charging facilities are available in the house.
- Unlimited WiFi is available for an N\$50 donation to the reserve's anti-poaching program. There is cell phone signal at the house.
