De Hoop – Jewel of the Cape

The De Hoop Nature reserve offers some of the best whale viewing in Southern Africa as well as a huge variety of fynbos, some endemic and rare. De Hoop also boasts abundant birdlife found both on the 19km fresh water vlei as well as along the coast and a good number of mammals like eland, bontebok, ostrich and Cape mountain zebra.

As of the 1st of September 2008 the De Hoop Collection, in partnership with Cape Nature took over most of the tourism activities and accommodation at De Hoop. All of the accommodation has been completely refurbished and is of a much higher standard. The self catering accommodation is all fully equipped with linen, bathroom towels and kitchen equipment and the cottages are serviced daily. There are also luxury suites available that includes breakfast and dinner in the rates. The Fig Tree Restaurant is available to all De Hoop guests. Picnic Baskets can also be ordered at reception.

Activities











Aside from the spectacular whale viewing there are numerous activities available to guests staying at De Hoop or just visiting for a day. These include interpretive guided walks through the fynbos and the rock pools, bird watching, hiking and mountain biking, to name a few.
