



LOCATION

Sasaab is located in the Westgate Community Conservancy, west of Samburu and Buffalo Springs National Reserves in Kenya's Northern Frontier District.

ACCOMMODATION

Sasaab has seven individual rooms and one family unit. The lodge can accommodate up to 18 guests. Each room is over 100 m² and has magnificent, elevated views overlooking the Ewaso Nyiro River. All rooms have private plunge pools and private en-suite open air bathrooms with showers and double sinks.

FACILITIES

- Each room has its own private plunge pool
- A central infinity pool with sunbeds and a pizza oven
- Wi-Fi in the rooms only
- Spa with gym and a pool
- Each room has mosquito nets over the beds
- All rooms have showers and handmade Kenyan toiletries, dressing gowns and flip flops provided
- In-room safes
- Each room has a fan
- Hair dryers available on request
- Cooler in rooms with a selection of drinks
- Laundry service included; due to cultural reasons, washing powder is provided for ladies to wash their own underwear
- Gym In A Bag: each bag contains a yoga mat, skipping rope and post-safari stretch card
- On-site vegetable garden & chicken coup

WEDDINGS

Sasaab is well equipped to host weddings. We recommend a civil wedding in the home country, prior to the ceremony.

GIVING BACK

Sasaab is located in the Westgate Community Conservancy, which is home to over 600 Samburu families. Prior to 2004, these people did not benefit much from tourism but the establishment of Sasaab Lodge and its many community projects has seen this trend completely reverse itself. Sasaab is closely involved with several local schools, the Westgate Community Conservancy and the Grevy's Zebra Trust.

The Safari Collection works alongside educational projects such as TEAMTalk and SAFE Samburu who work with the communities surrounding Westgate Conservancy and use sport or song as a vehicle for raising awareness about issues such as health, female empowerment, FGM reduction and HIV awareness. Sasaab is also proud to participate in The Safari Collection's annual health clinics, which bring essential medical care to remote communities where we operate.

Sasaab is committed to operating in a sustainable, environmentally friendly manner and is one of the few Gold eco-rated properties in Kenya. The lodge generates all its power and hot water via solar panels and embraces the national guidelines for operating in the most eco-conscious way.



ACTIVITIES

- Enjoy guided walks, bird watching, stargazing, swimming and a visit to SpaSaab.
- Go for a game drive in Samburu National Reserve or in the Westgate Conservancy.
- Start the day amidst pristine wilderness with a delicious bush breakfast and cap off the days' activities by dining under the stars with a bush dinner.
- Explore the area the traditional way by camel or opt to buzz around the bush on an ATV.
- Immerse yourself in Samburu culture and visit an authentic local village or witness a traditional ceremonial dance.
- Sip on sundowners at our special viewpoints and drift off to sleep under the Milky Way in our fly camp.

CHILDREN

Children are welcome and under-threes stay free. Extra beds are available on request. We recommend parents book the family suite (rooms 8 & 9), as it has a shared central area and pool. The family suite can also be taken as an exclusive-use villa. Our Samburu guides will teach children about their traditions and show them how to make bush tools. Special meals can be arranged with advanced notice. The lodge has drop off steps and pools in every room. Young children must be accompanied at all times.
