Situated deep in the national park on the ephemeral Luwi River, Time + Tide Luwi is wonderfully remote, with no other camps for miles around. Tranquillity envelops this camp, creating a wilderness haven that allows you to reconnect with nature in a meaningful way. Nestled in a grove of ancient mahogany trees, the tented suites are designed to fully immerse guests into the bush experience. From the comfort of your open air lounge, watch the diverse wildlife wandering by on the grassy floodplains. Listen to the hippos bellowing in the nearby lagoon and breathe in the heady aroma of African jasmine drifting past on a cool breeze. Sit back and let the peace of this place wash over you.

OPEN 20 MAY -31 OCTOBER

The start of the walking safari season, which runs from May to November.



September to November is best for seeing the iconic carmine bee-eaters.


> As the dry season approaches, large herds of elephants begin to drop by camp more often, drawn to drink at the nearby lagoon.





Peak season for our signature Sleepout Under the Stars is July to October.


KEY DESTINATION INTL AIRPORT DOMESTIC AIRPORT FLIGHT ROUTE




WALKING ROUTES
