We recommend the following:



Viewing Tower

Our 15m tower is a sweet spot for catching views of Mt. Kilimanjaro & the Big 5!



Stargazing Terrace
With no light pollution for miles and miles, enjoy the breathktaking African starlit sky from our sky gazing deck!



After your early morning game drive, enjoy a full breakfast, al fresco, in the middle of the bush surrounded by wildlife. An experience not to be missed.



Sundowner

Our Sundowner spot has fantastic views of Tsavo and Mt Kilimanjaro. Whilst you're enjoying drinks, bitings and the spectacular views, you can compete in a Masai Mock Olympics which includes bow and arrow shooting, club and spear throwing.



Spa/Wellness

Relax, Rejuvenate & Refresh yourself at our Chyulu Spa and Wellness Centre with splendid views of the majestic Chyulu Hills. Our luxurious spa facility is complete with a yoga deck, two air conditioned treatment rooms, an infinity spa pool, indoor and outdoor shower facilities, a hammam and a relaxation area.



Volcano Hike

A fantastic experience not to be missed. You will be driven to the foot of Ol Donyo Larami (inactive volcano) and partake in a hike to the top where there are magnificent views of the crater. You can opt to walk around it or soak in the spectacular views. We recommend this as a morning activity.



Yoga

Inhale, Exhale & Trust the yoga. Our elevated deck opens up to nature, connecting body and mind through yoga and meditation practices.



Nature Walk

This is a good opportunity to see the birds and smaller creatures around camp. The guide explains the medicinal value of trees and plants, how to recognize animal footprints and interesting facts on insects as well. Please speak to the front office to organize the bush walk.



Maasai Cultural Visit

We recommend a cultural visit to the nearby Lolarami Cultural Boma. The visit gives you a glimpse of the Maasai's daily lifestyle from milking the cows to building "Manyatta's", their traditional homes.



Shetani Lava Flow

Some 200 years ago, a stream of fiery magma erupted from the nearby Chyulu Hills. "Shetani" means "devil" in Kiswahili, named by the local community as they believed that it was the devil himself emerging from the earth. This vast expanse of folded black lava provides a spectacular view.



Chyulu Forest

A 45 minute drive and a 1 - 3 hour hike through lush rainforest which still shelters indigenous vegetation and wildlife with armed escorts provided. Truly an unforgettable experience.



Swahili Dinner

Enjoy a local food safari by sampling hand picked traditional dishes from East Africa. A menu is avilable upon request.
