



COVID-19 ON-SITE TESTING WITH AFRICA SAFE-T

What is the COVID-19 PCR TEST?

The COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test has the purpose of detecting the presence of genetic material (RNA) from the COVID-19 virus in the nasal or oral cavity. A sample is taken from the nose or throat using a swab.

Why is it important TO YOU?

Many countries around the world now require a COVID-19 PCR test to be conducted within 72 hours of departure (from the country of origin into South Africa, as well as on return from South Africa - including transited airports). The COVID-19 status of your guest on departure is as important as on their arrival to prevent the possibility of being guarantined on the way home.

With your guests often departing directly out of Johannesburg after they have left your property, testing in Johannesburg is not a feasible or convenient option.

We have THE SOLUTION

Africa SAFE-T is now able to conduct on-site testing on your property with one of our registered practitioners. Testing is conducted at Ampath Laboratories, one of South Africa's leading testing facilities. On-site testing will enable the guest to remain at your lodge without having to forfeit an entire day for the purpose of obtaining the required documentation before departure.

How it WORKS

- 1) You request the test via email at least 6 days prior to the guest's departure from South Africa.
- 2. We will respond with a date and time for the test to be performed within 48 hours of your initial request.
- You confirm the date and time via return email, and submit the required guest information for the laboratory form, which includes:
 - ID/Passport Number
 - Surname
 - Initials
 - First Name
 - Title

- Date of Birth (dd/mm/yyyy)
- Gender
- Patient Email
- Patient cell phone number
- Final destination
- Date and time of departure from South Africa
- Residential address

On the day of the confirmed test, the Africa SAFE-T qualified practitioner will arrive on-site 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time to set up. Testing takes about 15 minutes per person. The guest's information will be confirmed, and the sample packaged for dispatch to Ampath Laboratories.

Important:

- Guests may not eat or drink anything at least 30 minutes prior to the test being conducted.
- Ampath Laboratories have specific operating hours, and guests may need to miss out on planned lodge activities to ensure that the sample arrives in time.
- It is imperative that the scheduled time is observed, as practitioners are unable to wait considering the demand for this service.
- 5. You must make arrangements to have the sample delivered to your nearest Ampath Laboratory soon after being collected to ensure that results are released 24 hours prior to the guest's departure.

Important:

- We are unable to assist you with the delivery of samples to the laboratory as our practitioners need to remain on site in the reserve at all times.

- 6. We will email the stamped and signed results in the form of a certificate in English to the guest, and to the lodge if the guest has given permission to do so.
