




What can a Cub get up to?

Anything else I should know?

- Children of all ages are very welcome at Rock Lodge however we unfortunately don't allow Cubs under the age of 12 to stay at Safari Lodge for safety reasons. As long as your Cub is aged 6 or over he or she is more than welcome on the safari game vehicles.
- Please contact us prior to arrival for any special food and beverage requests for your Cubs and we'll do our best to accommodate these.
- In some rooms we can accommodate children on rollaway or fold out beds. The rates for accommodating children are available on request, however our 'Family' offer may be applicable so please ask.
- To make sure that we cause as little damage to the Sabi Sand Reserve
 as possible the total number of game vehicles we can send out is
 restricted. This means that if Ulusaba is almost fully booked we may not
 be able to accommodate extra children in rooms, but we'll make sure to
 let you know at the time of booking.
