BOATING & CANOEING

A boat safari is the only way to experience the wildness of Lake Urema - the heart of Gorongosa National Park and home to enormous crocodiles, hippos and amazing aquatic birdlife. Our canoe safaris carry you along the sandy beaches and the reed beds of the Pungue River, past pristine riparian forests. See wonderful birdlife and incredible photo opportunities along the way.

*Water activities are seasonal and run from March to May depending on water levels. Boating and canoeing safaris cannot be confirmed in advance.

E.O. WILSON LAB TOURS

The EO Wilson Laboratory is dedicated to training the next generation of Mozambican scientists. Students from the Park's Masters in Conservation Biology program document the park's flora and fauna, help track elephant herds and lion prides, and study complex relationships between fungi, plants, animals and insects. Programs like the Gorongosa Paleo-Primate Project shed light on the origins of humankind as it evolved out of Africa's Great Rift Valley.

PANGOLIN RESCUE CENTRE VISIT

Pangolins are the world's most trafficked mammal. See first hand the pioneering work of our rangers in rescuing pangolins from poachers and traffickers, and returning them to the wild where they belong. Subject to availability.

Gorongosa National Park is a birder's paradise with a breath-taking number of species, including the Green-headed Oriole - found nowhere else in southern Africa. See birds like the Southernground Hornbill, the Grey Crowned Crane, the Lilac Breasted Roller and a number of seasonal migrants.
