



MUZIMU FACT SHEET

Muzimu is Gorongosa's Tours first camp. This luxurious and exclusive tent lodge is located on the banks of the Mussicadzi River in the beautiful Gorongosa National Park, 4,000 square kilometers of untouched and undiscovered wilderness situated at the very end of the Africa's Great Rift Valley offering an incredible variety of landscapes to experience.

In addition to a perfect location, Muzimu offers an intimate experience. The Lodge has just six luxury East African style tents, each with own deck and en-suite bathroom, and offers a complete first-class safari experience, with a professional team to guide guests on their adventure in Gorongosa National Park, including walking safaris, driving and boat safaris.

ACCOMMODATION

- There are 6 Spacious East African style tents (canvas bungalows) each with in-suite bathroom and spacious deck, strategically positioned to offer guests comfortable seclusion and privacy.
- All Chalets offer an option of king size extra length or twin beds. All chalets have mosquito screens, tea-/coffee-making facilities, ceiling fan, safe and international outlets.

ACTIVITIES

The Park offers an amazing safari experience and it is a true paradise for ornithologists and wildlife enthusiasts. Among many other extraordinary species, sightings in Gorongosa and around Muzimu include lion, painted-wolf, leopard, elephant, buffalo, blue-wildebeest, crawshay's zebra, sable antelope, nyala and kudu.

All safaris (jeep, foot or boat) are led by qualified and experienced guides.

- Drive Safaris- each vehicle takes nine (9) people
- Walking Safari a max of 4 people and the
- Boating safari takes a max of 6 people (seasonal)
- Gorongosa Science Lab visits, Community cultural experiences, cannoeing, cycling, Mount Gorongosa Water-falls and visits to the coffee and honey projects.

CHILD POLICY

At Muzimu no children under twelve (-12 y).

Children from twelve (+12) will be charged adult rate. Children between twelve and sixteen (12 -16) years of age are required to share a room with an adult family member. Children from sixteen (16) may be accommodate in own room (sharing or single). NOTE: This policy may be reviewed and reconsidered when booking sole/exclusive use of Muzimu. In which case, one (1) Child under twelve (-12) can share with adult family members if sharing the same bed,

there is no space for an extra bed. Children under 12 will be accommodated free of charge and on the same meal plan as paying family members

ACCESS

- Road from Beira (+/- 4h) and/or from Chimoio (+/- 2,5h)
- Light aircraft transfers (duration: +/- 30 minutes), due to the use of light aircraft for your air transfer, you are requested to limit your luggage to a MAXIMUM OF 15KG and to utilise SOFT LUGGAGE CARRIERS. Failure to do so may result in luggage arrival being delayed and / or incurring extra costs.
- Guests arriving in Beira/Chimoio after 4 pm must stay overnight in the city and will be transferred to the Park the following morning

PARK CLOSURE

Due to the rainy season in the region, the Park operates between mid-March and December (depends on the rainy season).

PAYMENT

- Payments for extras made at the Lodge, can be made in cash, by transfer or by Credit Card; and in MZN, USD, EURO, ZAR or British Pound (GBP).
- The Lodge accepts payment with MasterCard and Visa. A 4% fee applies to all credit card payments

MALARIA

The malaria-carrying mosquito occurs throughout the national territory. All windows in the units and beds are protected with mosquito nets. However, it is recommended that guests take precaution measures, such as the use of repellents and / or prophylaxis before entering a malaria region.
