#### PAYMENT POLICY

A confirmed booking comprises the following terms & conditions:

- Full payment must be received by Gorongosa Safaris no later than 30 days prior to arrival.
- Reservations made less than 30 days prior to arrival will require full payment within 48 hours.
- The Lodge accepts payment with MasterCard and Visa. A 4% fee applies to all credit card payments

#### CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation must be made in writing and the conditions of cancellation are as follows:

- 30 days and less: 100% is forfeited.
- No shows: 100% cancellation fees
- No refund will be given for guests who arrive but leave before the completion of their stay.
- An admin fee of 3% of the total deposit/payment will be applied, should a refund be required.

#### EXCLUSIVE USE POLICIES

A confirmed booking comprises the following terms & conditions:

- 25% Deposit due within 7 days of confirmation.
- Balance payment must be received by Gorongosa Safaris no later than 45 days prior to arrival.
- If cancelled 46 days or more before arrival date, no cancellation fees.
- 45 days and less: 100% is forfeited
- An admin fee of 3% of the total deposit/payment will be applied, should a refund be required.

#### STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All bank charges are to be covered by the guest, agent, or operator. If a refund is paid by Gorongosa Safaris, then the bank charges for the refund will be deducted from the refund payment.
- Road transfers and any other activities are nett and non-commissionable.
- Incorrect quotes or charges to the guest will be covered by the booking agent or operator.
- Provisional bookings will be held for a maximum of 14 days unless an extension has been requested in writing and has been approved.


### GENERAL INFORMATION

AREA	Gorongosa National Park, Mozambique
ACCESS	<ul> <li>Road from Beira (+/- 4h) and/or from Chimoio (+/- 2,5h)</li> <li>Guests arriving in Beira/Chimoio after 2 pm must overnight in the city and will be transferred to the Park the following morning.</li> <li>Light aircraft transfers from Beira to Gorongosa National Park (duration: +/- 30 minutes). Due to the use of light aircraft transfer, you are requested to limit your luggage to a MAXIMUM OF 15 KG and to utilise SOFT LUGGAGE CARRIERS. Failure to do so may result in luggage arrival being delayed and / or incurring extra costs.</li> <li>Light aircraft transfers from other domestic and regional destinations are available upon enquiry.</li> </ul>
CHILDREN	Children under 12 years old cannot be accommodated. Children aged 12 and above will be charged at the adult rate. Children aged 12 to 16 must share a chalet or tent with an adult family member. Children aged 16 and above may be accommodated in their own room, either sharing or single.
MALARIA	Malaria-carrying mosquitoes are common in our area. While we provide mosquito nets on all windows and beds, we recommend using repellents or taking prophylaxis before visiting malaria-prone regions.
MEALS & BEVERAGES	Fully inclusive: all meals, & drinks. Please advise dietary requirements before arrival.

BOATING & CANOEING WHEN IN SEASON	Water activities are seasonal and run from March to May depending on water levels.


### GORONGOSA FLY CAMP


