TRANSPORTATION

International flights arrive to O R tambo International Airport, closest Gateway Airport is at Polokwane.

Rent a car drive is 5 1/2 hours North from O R Tambo to Mopane. *We can arrange meet & greet, and transfer if needed.

VISITOR INFORMATION

Climate: Semi-arid. Hot and dry for much of the year. There is a rainy season which occurs in the summer months of October to March. October and April is frequently above 30° C / 86° F.

Power: Mopane Bush Lodge has mains electricity supply – 230volts @ 50 Hertz. Each chalet is fitted with a shaver plug which has a 110volt outlet which can be used for a shaver and charging portable battery powered equipment rated 110volts.

Suggested items to pack:

Comfortable walking shoes, swimming costumes, sun hats, sunglasses, sunscreen, cameras and binoculars.

Summer: Lightweight clothing and swimming costumes, warm clothing for game drives.

Winter: Light clothing for daytime, warm clothing for evening and very warm insulated jackets for game drives.

The closest town is Musina (Messina), 63km to the East. The road to our front gate is tarred all the way. There is only a short distance of gravel from road to the lodge.

Adjacent is the **UNESCO World Heritage Site of Mapungubwe National Park**, where the Limpopo and SACHE rivers merge. The park offers a glimpse into the Iron Age with its archeological sites, as well as offering **one of the top 10 San rock art locations** in South Africa.
