



#### LOCATION

Sala's camp is located at the convergence of the Sand and Keekorok Rivers, in the heart of the Masai Mara. It is perfectly situated as the first Mara property to welcome the annual wildebeest migration, from July to September, when over a million gnus pour into the Masai Mara from the Serengeti.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

Sala's Camp received a major makeover in 2016 and now boasts seven large, new tents and can accommodate up to 22 people. There are three superior tents, two honeymoon tents and two family tents. Bathrooms have hot rainfall showers and flushing toilets. Some of the tents have solar-heated water while others use wood-fired 'kuni boosters'. Electricity is solar powered, with a generator for back-up.

# **FACILITIES**

- Plunge pools in all tents
- Wi-Fi in the mess area
- In-room beautician offering a variety of treatments
- All rooms have showers and some have baths
- Safe in every tent
- Handmade Kenyan toiletries, dressing gowns and flip flops
- Laundry service included but due to cultural reasons hand wash powder is provided for ladies intimates
- Gym In A Bag: each bag contains a yoga mat, skipping rope and a post-safari stretch card

#### **GIVING BACK**

Sala's Camp employs local Maasai people from the surrounding communities as guides and as members of staff. Each quest that stays at Sala's Camp pays park and conservation fees, a percentage of which is fed back into local community projects and to the rhino monitoring team to help with fuel, training and surveillance of the endangered rhinos that reside near the camp. Sala's Camp also works in close conjunction with the Mara Cheetah and Mara Lion Projects, assisting with fundraising, data collection and by providing a base for project staff when they are in the area. The Safari Collection also works alongside educational projects such as TEAMTalk who work with school communities surrounding the Mara that involves the use of sport as a vehicle for raising awareness about issues such as health, female empowerment, FGM reduction and HIV awareness. Sala's is also proud to participate in The Safari Collection's annual health clinics, which bring essential medical care to remote communities where we operate. Like its sister properties, Sasaab and Solio, Sala's Camp is a gold rated eco-lodge, signifying that it operates under the strictest guidelines of sustainability and continually strives to leave as minimal an impact on its surroundings as possible.

















### **ACTIVITIES**

Game drives in one of the world's most prolific wildlife areas. The Masai Mara is home to Africa's 'Big Five', as well as the world-famous annual migration of wildebeest. Star gazing is superb here. Admire the birdlife on nature walks within the camp or play volleyball in the Sand River (seasonal). For more information please read our activities and extras document.

### **CHILDREN**

Children are welcome and under-threes stay free. Extra beds are available on request and family tents have additional space. The local Maasai are keen to teach their traditions and will show children how to throw a 'rungu', tie a 'shuka' and make a bow & arrow. Activities also include searching for the 'toothbrush tree', spotting the 'Little Five' and the 'Ugly Five' on game drives, and finding spoor in the riverbed. Babysitters and special meals can be made by prior arrangement.


