

INTRODUCTION

Perched high on a koppie and with expansive views of the Waterberg Mountains, Bushwa Private Game Lodge is situated in a malaria free area of the Limpopo Province.

This hidden gem, with accommodation including the main lodge and a treehouse, offers a variety of activities – from guided game drives, lazy days at the swimming pool to spa treatments of the ultra luxurious kind. At less than three hours drive from Johannesburg, it is the ideal breakaway spot from the hustle and bustle of city life.

With a prolific bird and animal life and delectable local cuisine, this piece of bushveld paradise will sooth the soul.

TYPICAL DAY AT BUSHWA PRIVATE GAME LODGE

Each morning begins with a game drive in the Waterberg region, followed by breakfast. Daily schedule is as follows (depending on season):

- 06h15 - Wakeup call followed by coffee and rusks at the lodge
- 06h15 - 09h00 - Morning game drive, or other pre-planned activity
- 09h00 - 11h00 - A gourmet breakfast is served, and guests will spend the rest of the day at leisure
- 14h00 - Light lunch
- 16h00 - 19h00 - Afternoon and evening game drive, complete with sundowners
- 19h30 - A three-course dinner is served. After dinner guests can relax in the dining area or around the camp fire on boma evenings.

LOCATION

Bushwa Private Game Lodge is located in a private reserve within the Greater Waterberg Biosphere in the Limpopo province, and is an easy self-drive journey, with the closest town being Vaalwater and the closest major international airport being O.R Tambo.

HOW TO GET THERE

Bushwa Private Game Lodge is located in a private reserve within the Greater Waterberg Biosphere in the Limpopo province, and is an easy self-drive journey, with the closest town being Vaalwater and the closest major international airport being O.R Tambo.

There are Toll gates en route, so do be aware that you will need to pay road tolls. We estimate the drive to be between 2 - 3 hours, dependent on traffic. Follow the R21 from O.R Tambo towards Pretoria, the R21 becomes the N1. Follow the N1 through Pretoria until you reach a toll gate (Kranskop) where you will take the Modimolle/Nylstroom turn-off.

Directions for High Clearance Vehicles

Head towards Vaalwater, turn right at the SPAR shop onto the R33 Ellisras/Lepalale Road. After 10km turn right at the Zanddrift dirt road for 5km. Turn left at Bushwa Game lodge sign.

Directions for Low & High Clearance Vehicles

Inside Vaalwater, turn right at the 4-way stop onto the D972 Melkrivier Road. After 10km turn left at the Waterval (D2745) sign onto a dirt road. Continue 3.3km. Turn right at Bushwa Game Lodge Sign.

After passing through 2 security gates (codes to be provided) you will arrive at Bushwa Lodge after 4 Km.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFO:

Weather

Daytime temperatures range between 14 and 25°C. The dry season runs from May to September, with June and July relatively cool and August and September hot and humid. The wet season begins in November and finishes in March. April is autumn and a transition month while late September to early November is spring. While its levels of annual rainfall – which range between 485mm and 719mm – are not exceptional, there are plenty of permanent sources of water.

Wildlife

The Waterberg has a wider variety of flora and fauna than elsewhere in Africa. The diverse reserve sustains over 40 species of game including buffalo, sable, giraffe, nyala, gemsbok (oryx), kudu, eland, blue wildebeest (gnu), red hartebeest, zebra, impala, bushbuck, duiker, steenbuck, mountain reedbuck, waterbuck, warthog, blesbuck, baboons, bushpig, klipspringer, leopard, jackal, brown hyena, caracal, civet and genet to name but a few.

In addition there are well over 300 species of resident and migrant birds.

Game Drive Vehicles

Take full advantage of the best times of the day for game viewing, dawn and dusk. Open safari vehicles with expert guides offer prime viewing experiences and an educational opportunity.

WHAT TO PACK
