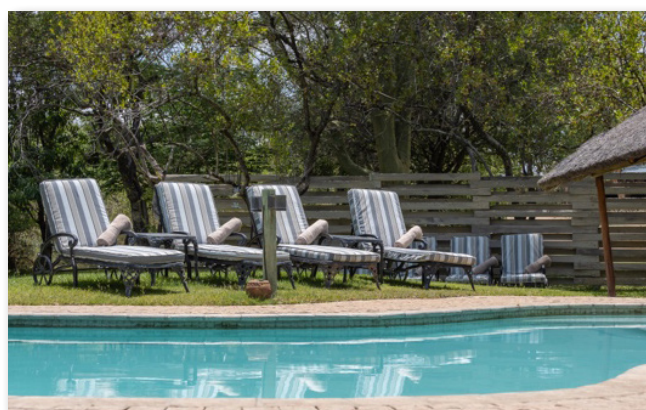

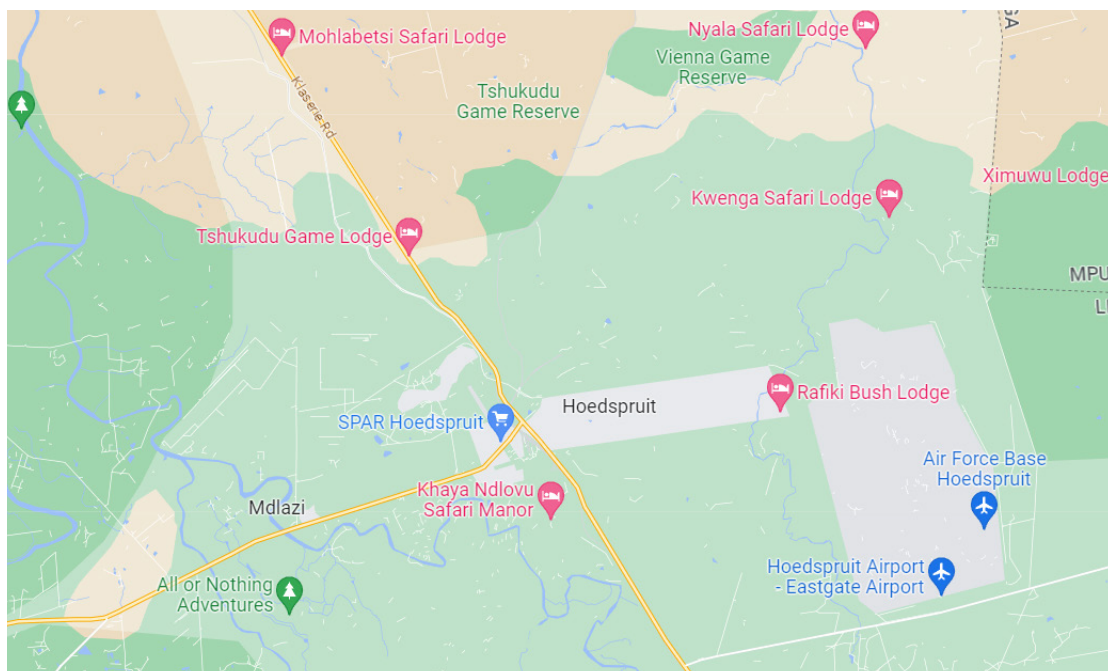

Pass through the York Gate and travel 7 kms straight down a good condition dirt road and drive right into the camp.
